We believe in learning language -- it adds such value and depth to relationship. Right now our monthly budget does not allow for language classes (approximately \$100/month or \$1200/year). Several months ago, Jacob and I were discussing with another missionary how Pol Pot created a horrific wasteland in Cambodians' souls when he destroyed their nation. He made an off-hand comment, "When people experience trauma and devastation to that degree, they lose sight of hope and vision." The idea resonated and began germinating in our hearts. What happens when people lose sight of vision? Or if life shatters hope altogether?

Here in America we grow up dreaming. Little kids plan what they want to be when they grow up and no possibility is too big. That's why I rehearsed my Oscar speech after my parents put me to bed and why Jacob imagined performing surgeries as a doctor. (If you know Jacob at all, you realize he still holds onto this childhood dream in some fashion.) Most of us have these childhood memories. Over time, these wonderings become tapered to reality. And as believers, we hopefully find that walking with Jesus shapes our dreams to kingdom purposes. But at times, no matter your culture or background, life's challenges can threaten (at times successfully) to steal purpose and dash hopes. Grief -- the kind brought on by extreme poverty, heart-breaking loss and trauma -- has a way of numbing the soul. Life becomes survival. Dreaming is a luxury and risk.

Cambodians have reasons to live without hope--many do. But a growing number are coming alive in new ways. Pheaktra, an In His Steps staff member, is a young man full of tenderness and vision for his people. One night he dreamt about a family who needed God's love. In the dream, God told him to look for the ones with the broken heart. He spent the next day driving his moto village to village, searching. Incredibly he found them -- a family of five who had just lost their wife and mother. They were known by their village as -- yep, you guessed it -- the family with the broken heart. Imagine with us a Cambodia where more men, women and children dream like Pheaktra and live purposefully for God?

Remember Joel's prophesy later repeated in Acts? "In the last days, God says, 'I will pour out my Spirit on all people. Your sons and daughters will prophesy, your young men will see visions, your old men will dream dreams.' " It is **our** hope and vision to see God's dreams and purposes fulfilled in and through the Cambodian people. Thanks for partnering with us.
