One of the greatest of 2009 was the addition in the Spring of a beautiful, 1,500square-foot deck overlooking the ravine and Colllins Run behind the facility. (pictured at left, in process) Also throughout the year, sound improvements were made with the installation of a sound booth for the drums and multiple sound absorption panels on the west wall of the auditorium (as well as sound absorption material below the stage). Also added to the auditorium: a beautiful central staircase for the stage, increasing utility for weekly worship, stage presentations, and weddings.
