
Bob and Robin have two grown children, Aubrey and Aaron, who have given them three beautiful grandchildren.



The Bible describes, in 1 Kings 19, a time when the man of God, the prophet Elijah, reached a crisis point at the end of an intense time of ministry. God's servant needed a time of rest and renewal, and a fresh commission from God. Mt.
