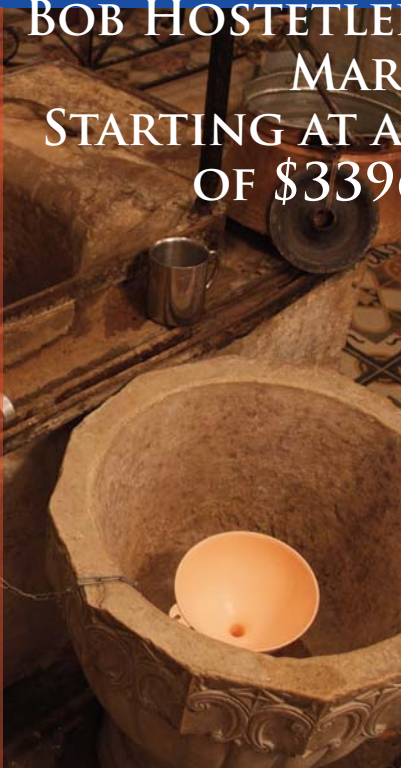

DAY BY DAY ITINERARY

Day 1 and 2 - USA to the Holy Land

Your spiritual pilgrimage begins as you depart the USA on an international flight. You will be welcomed to the Holy Land by our airport representative and transferred to your Bethlehem hotel for dinner and overnight.

Day 3 - Jericho and Qumran



Visit the Baptismal Site at **Kasr el Yehud**, the traditional site of the baptism of Jesus by John the Baptist. **Jericho** is the oldest known inhabited city in the world. Visit the ruins of the ancient city, which was conquered by Joshua (Josh. 6: 1,2,20). From Jericho you can see the traditional **site of the Temptation of Jesus** (Matt.4: 1-11) and the Judean wilderness.

Travel to **Qumran**, site of the Dead Sea Scroll discovery, to discuss the mysterious community of Essenes who once lived on the shores of the Dead Sea. End your day with a chance to take a dip in the mineral laden waters of the **Dead Sea**.

Day 4 - Herodion and Bethlehem

Begin your touring by visiting missions sites and by viewing the **Herodion**, the fortified palace and final resting place of Herod the Great. In **Bethlehem** visit the cave where Jesus was born and the church which has been constructed on the site (Matthew 1: 18-25; Luke 2: 1-7). Nearby, visit the **Shepherds' Field** where the Good News was first heard.

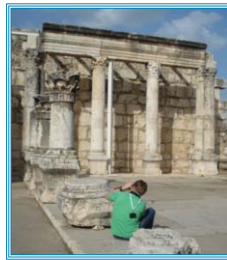
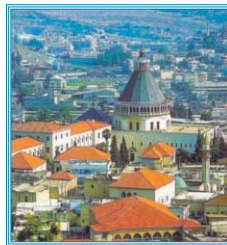


Day 5 - Caesarea, Mt. Carmel & Megiddo

Visit the **Roman Aqueduct and Theatre** at **Caesarea**, a center of the early Christians. Here, Cornelius became the first Gentile convert to the new religion (Acts 10) and Paul was imprisoned before being taken to Rome for Trial. Ascend **Mt. Carmel** where Elijah defeated the prophets of Baal and overlook modern day Haifa (I Kings 18). Travel the ancient caravan route through the **Jezreel Valley** to **Tel Megiddo** where 20 different cities lie superimposed upon each other.

Day 6 - Jacob's Well, Samaria, Nazareth, Cana

Today visit modern day **Nablus** (ancient Shechem) and see Jacob's Well where Christ encountered the Samaritan woman (John 4). See **Mt. Ebal** and **Mt. Gerizim** where the Israelites recited the blessings and curses of the Law. Continue to **Samaria**, the capital of the Northern Kingdom, and home to Ahab and Jezebel. Continue past **Tel Dothan**, thought to be the place where Joseph found his brothers with their flocks (Genesis 37). Visit **Nazareth**, Jesus' boyhood home (Matthew 2: 23) and **Cana**, the site of Christ's first miracle.

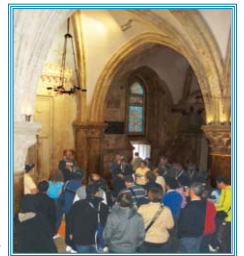


Day 7 - The Galilee

Travel to **Capernaum**, the center of Jesus' ministry in the Galilee. Visit the synagogue which stands on the site where Jesus taught. Recall his teaching and preaching the gospel of the kingdom (Matt.4:13). Travel to the **Mt. of Beatitudes** where Jesus preached to the people (Matt. 5-7). Cross the waters of the **Sea of Galilee**. Along the way, participate in a special on board worship service. At **Tabgha**, the traditional location for the calling of the disciples and the feeding of the 5000, you'll visit the **Church of the Fish and the Loaves** (Luke 9:10-17). You'll also visit the **Chapel of the Primacy** where three times Peter professed his devotion to the risen Christ (John 21).

Day 8 - Jerusalem

Stand atop the **Mount of Olives** as Jesus did and enjoy a remarkable view of the "Golden City" of Jerusalem, including the Temple Mount and Dome of the Rock. Forty days after His resurrection, Jesus ascended into heaven from the Mount of Olives (Acts 1: 9-12). Walk to the **Garden of Gethsemane** and pray there as Jesus prayed (Matt.26:36-44). Stroll down the Kidron Valley to the **Gihon Spring**, the ancient water source of the city of Jerusalem and see the entrance to **Hezekiah's Tunnel**. On Mount Zion you will view the site of **King David's Tomb**. Stand in the **Upper Room**, revered as the site of the Last Supper (Mark 14: 12-26).

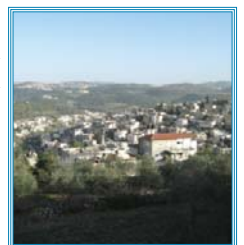


Day 9 Jerusalem

This morning enjoy a walking tour of the **Old City of Jerusalem**, and walk the **Cardo**, the ancient main street of the Old City once lined with shops and now partially restored. Visit the **Davidson Center** and the **Southern Wall Excavations** including the **Teaching Steps**, and the **Western Wall**. View the **Pool of Bethesda** (John 5: 1-31) where Jesus performed the Sabbath miracle. Visit **Herod's Antonia Fortress** where Jesus was brought before Pontius Pilate (Luke 23: 1-11). Walk the **Via Dolorosa**, "the Way of the Cross," and stand in reverence at the **Church of the Holy Sepulchre**. Visit the **Garden Tomb**, possible site of the garden of Joseph of Arimathea and experience the reality of the Resurrection.

Day 10 Nebi Samuel, Emmaus, Valley of Elah

Visit **Nebi Samuel**, thought to be the burial place of the prophet Samuel and for a final view of Jerusalem. Travel to **Emmaus** where Jesus, after His resurrection, was invited to visit with two of his disciples who did not recognize Him until He blessed and broke bread with them (Luke 24:13-17, 28-31). Finally, journey through the Valley of Elah, where David defeated Goliath (I Samuel 17). **(Miss this day of touring in Israel and leave for Egypt or Jordan if you are participating in an Optional Extension to Jordan or Egypt.)**



Day 11 Return to the USA or Enjoy an Extension...

EXTENSIONS

Cairo & the Route of the Exodus

4-day extension \$698*

Day 10 Depart Jerusalem and travel ancient caravan routes across the **Sinai Desert** to the base of **Mount Sinai** for overnight.

Day 11 Visit the **Monastery of Saint Catherine** at the base of **Mount Sinai**. Travel to **Wadi Feiran** where the Children of Israel withstood the Amalekites. Move on to **Elim** where the Children of Israel camped by the oasis of 70 palm trees. Your final stop of the day will be **Marah** by the **Red Sea** where the "waters were bitter." Dinner & Overnight in **Cairo**.

Day 12 Travel as Abraham did to **Memphis** and on to **Sakkara** to see the **Step Pyramid**, the world's oldest stone structure. See the **Great Pyramids of Giza** and the **Sphinx**.

Day 13 Admire ancient treasures, including King Tut's, at the **Egyptian Museum**. Explore the famous **Citadel of Old Cairo** and **Coptic Church**. **Sail the Nile River aboard an authentic Egyptian Felucca**.

Day 14 Depart Egypt and arrive in the USA.



Nile Cruise

7-day extension \$1348*

Day 10 - 11 Same as Cairo and the Route of the Exodus (see above).

Day 12 Admire the ancient treasures of the **Egyptian Museum**. Continue and visit the **Great Pyramids of Giza** and the **Sphinx**. This afternoon you will fly to Aswan & board your Nile Cruise boat.

Day 13 Sail to **Aswan**. Visit the **High Dam** and the granite quarry where you can see the unfinished obelisk. Visit the **Temple of Philae** and the **Temple of Kom Ombo**.

Day 14 **Temple of Horus** in **Edfu**. Continue via the Nile Lock and sail to **Luxor**.

Day 15 Disembark. Cross to the **West Bank** of the Nile where you will visit the **Necropolis of Thebes**, the **Valley of the King and Queens**, the **Temple of Hatshepsut** and the **Colossi of Memnon**. Fly back to **Cairo** for dinner and overnight.

Day 16 and 17 - Depart Egypt and arrive in the USA.



Wonders of Jordan & Petra

3-day extension \$648*

Day 10 In the morning, you will cross the Allenby Bridge into Jordan. View the "promised land" as Moses did from the summit of **Mt. Nebo**. Nearby **Madaba** is home to a beautiful 6th century mosaic of Jerusalem. Visit Philadelphia, one of the ten cities of the Decapolis, and now **Amman**.

Day 11 Early in the morning you'll journey to the famous rock city of **Petra**, literally cut into the cliff sides. Return to Amman for a late dinner and overnight.

Day 12 - 13 Explore the ruins of **Jerash**, Jordan's best-preserved Graeco-Roman town. In the evening depart the Holy Land and arrive in the USA.
