## Details: Ways to Give

### Budget:

- Server and 6 workstations = \$8,250 (est.)
- Misc hardware including a projector/screen, battery backups, etc. = \$1,422 (est.)
- Software including server and workstations = \$5,240 (est.)
- Furniture and Construction Supplies = \$1,011 (est.)

**Total Estimated Budget = \$15,923 (est.)**
