Spring Cleaning

Sizes 6.5", 7.5", 8.5", with notes to make any size

Gauge ~5 sts/in in garter

Materials and Notions

Worsted Weight Cotton (~25-55 yds) Sugar'n Cream Peaches & Cream US 7 (4.5mm) needles 2 stitch markers

Abbreviations

k = knit
p = purl
kfb = knit into the front and back of a
 stitch
k2tog = knit 2 stitches together
ssk = slip 2 stitches as if to knit and
 knit them together
w&t = wrap and turn
sts = stitches



Note: For a smaller or larger cloth, add or subtract increments of 6, to change the size by 1" for every 6 stitches. Below are a few numbers to get you started. If your gauge is very different, have fun playing with the numbers to get any size you want.

28 = 6.5" 34 = 7.5" 40 = 8.5" 46 = 9.5" 52 = 10.5"

Cast on 6 sts. Row 1: kfb, place marker, k4, place marker, kfb Row 2: k to marker, p4, k to end Row 3: k to 1 stitch before marker, kfb, k4, kfb, knit to end Row 4: k to marker, p4, k to end

Repeat rows 3 and 4 until there are 28 (34, 40) sts or desired number of sts on the needle.

Row 5: k to 1st stitch before marker, w&t, knit back to beginning of row

Repeat row 5, continuing to wrap every other stitch (3, 5, 7, 9, 11, ...) until every other stitch is wrapped on that half of the cloth.

Row 6: k to the last wrapped st, w&t, knit back to beginning of row

Repeat row 6, wrapping the 2nd (3rd, 4th, 5th, ...)last wrapped st, until all wrapped sts have been worked.

Row 7: k to 2 sts before marker, ssk, k4, k to end

Repeat rows 5 and 6 for the second wedge.

Row 8: k to 2 sts before marker, ssk, p4, k to end Row 9: k to 2 sts before marker, ssk, k4, k2tog, k to end Row 10: k to marker, p4, k to end

Repeat rows 9 and 10, ending on 9, until there are 6 sts left and bind off.
