4 Days of Bible Study with David Clayton and Howard Williams from Restoration Ministries



God blessed us with a wonderful camp meeting this year in Wenatchee, WA. We are happy and thankful to our Heavenly Father that a work of spreading the gospel started in this area, too. We need the light in the darkness and discovered that we are not alone! In fact there are a lot of souls who believe in the Truth and are seeking God just as we are. It was such a blessing to find like-believers and worship together with these brothers and sisters.

We invited brother David Clayton and brother Howard Williams of Restoration Ministries from Jamaica who brought us very precious messages. The camp meeting started on the 8th of July, on Thursday morning at 9:30 AM. We were able to find and rent a meeting room with a kitchen facility in Wenatchee. We had 4 sermons on the first day with a lot of discussions between them.

On Friday we also had 4 presentations, and after the last message we went to Leavenworth to the Icicle river for a baptism. We felt the work of the Holy Spirit among us, and our hearts were united.

On Sabbath more people came, and it seemed like everybody wanted to learn more and more and the day was just not long enough. All of us were blessed with the precious truths that were presented, and our “amen”s were echoed back after every sermon. In the evening we prayed for the sick and there were a couple people who requested the laying on of hands.

On Sunday we had just 2 sermons in Wenatchee because we needed to leave the facility by 1 PM. After the meetings everybody stayed together and we went up to the house of brother Eldon Noyes where we had communion service. It was such a blessing to learn about the real meaning of communion just a couple hours before we were actual partakers of it! It is a point of contact when God and His Son especially come close to us with their presents. We all opened our hearts to Them and were richly blessed. After the

communion more people requested the laying on of hands and we prayed for them. Late afternoon came, and it seemed that nobody wanted to leave. Finally the group started to break up and we said farewell and “pray we will be able to do this again next year” to all our dear brothers and sisters.

These four days brought us unspeakable blessings. We felt that our religion became real and our Heavenly Father is really close to us. It is so beautiful how He can open up passages from the Bible to us that we might read hundreds of times before but didn't see what they really say. It is wonderful to break free from traditions and customs that our upbringing or the church we belong(ed) to put on us, and see the truths of the Bible in their clarity. It is empowering to dare to believe what the Bible says and claim it in our lives. Our religion becomes so real and our God becomes so close.
