The curtain opens on the courtyard of Cape's Bluff High School in Southern California. There is a large gathering of STUDENTS, ready for a pep rally. RUBY, a new student, and smart, girl-next-door LANIE, enter downstage together.

LANIE

So that concludes our little tour of Cape's Bluff High. You think you're all set for your first day?

RUBY

I hope so. Just one more question, Lanie?

LANIE

Sure.

RUBY

What's all this here?

LANIE

Oh. Unfortunately, it's a pep rally. The All County Tournament's tomorrow and, of course, here everything academic bows to anything athletic. Just like any high school. You said you were a debater, right?

RUBY

Dancer, actually.

LANIE

Great. Just great. We always do this when The Johnny is about to win something.

RUBY

The what?

LANIE

At Cape's Bluff High, we call the most popular kid in the senior class, "The Johnny," no matter what his real name is.

RUBY

What's this one's name?

LANIE

Johnny. It's a fairly recent tradition. Oh, look. The dog and pony show's about to begin.

(STUDENTS cheer as the PRINCIPAL enters.)

PRINCIPAL

Cape's Bluff Wolverines, you all know why we're here. Let's hear it for your next tournament champion, Johnny Zabka!

(JOHNNY enters, and the place goes bananas.)

MALE STUDENT Good luck at the big tournament tomorrow, Johnny!

BOBBY You're gonna do great, Johnny!

FEMALE STUDENT

You're the best, Johnny!

"THE JOHNNY"

JOHNNY (SUNG)

TAKE ONE LOOK AT ME AND YOU KNOW JUST WHAT YOU'LL FIND THERE'S A GUY LIKE ME IN EVERY HIGH SCHOOL AND WE'RE ALL ONE OF A KIND

CAPTAIN OF EVERY TEAM PRESIDENT OF THE CLASS SUNKISSED BLONDE HAIR, BABY BLUE EYES ALL YOU LOSERS CAN KISS MY ASS BECAUSE

I KNOW THAT YOU SAY THAT YOU HATE ME

STUDENTS (SUNG)

YOU HATE HIM.

JOHNNY (SUNG) JUST 'CAUSE YOU WANT TO BE ME.

STUDENTS (SUNG)

YOU BE HIM.

JOHNNY (SUNG) BECAUSE YOU HATE YOURSELVES AND YOU WANT TO LOVE YOURSELVES. SO BY HATING ME, YOU'RE LOVING ME.

STUDENTS

WHAT TWISTED SELF-ESTEEM.

JOHNNY (SUNG)

YES, YOU'RE LOVING THE JOHNNY

STUDENTS (SUNG)

THE JOHNNY.

JOHNNY (SUNG) DON'T HAVE TO TRY, I JUST WIN THAT'S RIGHT, I'M JOHNNY.

STUDENTS (SUNG)

THE JOHNNY.

JOHNNY (SUNG) I'M THE YANG TO FAILURE'S YIN.

JOHNNY (SUNG) STUDENTS (SUNG) MY LIFE IS SO GREAT AND I CAN'T AHH EVER SEE THAT CHANGING AHH 'CAUSE WHEN YOU'RE THE JOHNNY AHH

STUDENTS (SUNG)

THE JOHNNY

JOHNNY (SUNG) YOU KNOW THAT YOU'RE THE KING OF HIGH SCHOOL

(LANIE steps out and speaks to everyone.)

LANIE (SPOKEN)

I can't believe we're doing this for just one person! Johnny's not the only one competing tomorrow.

BOBBY (SPOKEN) We know, Lanie. I am too, but you don't see me making a fuss about it.

LANIE (SPOKEN)

What about Kyle Weaver?

BOBBY (SPOKEN) That little twerp?? You must be joking. He'll never beat a guy as rad as Johnny!!

PRINCIPAL (SPOKEN) Lanie, can we get on with the pep rally, please.

JOHNNY (SUNG)

I CAN ACT LIKE AN ASSHOLE AND STILL EVERYONE IS MY FRIEND I HAD SEX AT THIRTEEN AND EVERY NIGHT SINCE THEN

MY FAMILY IS FILTHY RICH THEY GOT ME A NEW CAR EVERY COLLEGE IS LOOKING AT ME THEY WANNA MAKE ME A STAR I KNOW THAT YOU THINK I'M JUST LUCKY

STUDENTS (SUNG) JUST LUCKY JOHNNY (SUNG) AND THAT I DON'T DESERVE IT STUDENTS (SUNG) DESERVE IT JOHNNY (SUNG) BUT I'LL TAKE IT ALL AND YOUR GIRLFRIEND TOO (Dance break.) STUDENTS (SUNG) YEAH, HE NAILED HER. JOHNNY (SUNG) SHE'S NOW WITH THE JOHNNY STUDENTS (SUNG) THE JOHNNY JOHNNY (SUNG) I CANT IMAGINE SECOND PLACE I'M JOHNNY STUDENTS (SUNG) THE JOHNNY JOHNNY (SUNG) I'LL KNEECAP YOU TO WIN THE RACE. JOHNNY (SUNG) STUDENTS (SUNG) I COULD KILL A GUY AHH AND GET OFF WITH A WARNING AHH 'CAUSE WHEN YOU'RE THE JOHNNY AHH STUDENTS THE JOHNNY JOHNNY (SUNG) YOU KNOW THAT YOU'RE THE KING OF HIGH SCHOOL IN CAPE'S BLUFF, CALIFORNIA. BOBBY (SPOKEN) You ready to do some damage, J-Man?

JOHNNY (SPOKEN) Absolutely, Bobby Boy. I bet if I weren't in the tournament, you'd win it for sure.

BOBBY (SUNG) SOME THINK IT WOULDN'T BE EASY ALWAYS BEING SECOND PLACE BUT WHEN YOU'RE WITH THE JOHNNY IT'S THE LIFE YOU MUST EMBRACE.

ALL THE GIRLS SWOON FOR HIM THERE'S NOTHING I WOULDN'T DO FOR HIM THANK GOD I'VE LEARNED TO REPRESS

BOBBY (SUNG)STUDENTS (SUNG)WHAT I FEELWHAT HE FEELSFOR THE JOHNNY.WHAT HE FEELS

STUDENTS (SUNG)

THE JOHNNY

BOBBY (SUNG) OR IT'D ALL CAUSE A GREAT BIG MESS.

RUBY (SPOKEN)

Who's this Kyle Weaver?

LANIE (SPOKEN)

Kyle was a new kid this year and he and I became really good friends. Kyle and Johnny got into it a few times, and they're going to settle it at the tournament tomorrow. Plus, I think Kyle's gonna ask me out soon.

RUBY (SPOKEN) That's sweet. You think Kyle's gonna beat Johnny?

LANIE (SPOKEN)

No way.

JOHNNY (SUNG) I'VE GOT A NEW CHANCE TOMORROW

STUDENTS (SUNG)

TOMORROW

JOHNNY (SUNG)

TO PROVE HOW GREAT I AM

STUDENTS (SUNG)

GREAT HE AM

JOHNNY (SUNG)

THERE'S SOME SCRAWNY KID BUT WHO REALLY CARES?

STUDENTS (SUNG) WHEN DO UNDERDOGS EVER WIN? JOHNNY (SUNG) NOT AGAINST THE JOHNNY STUDENTS (SUNG) THE JOHNNY JOHNNY (SUNG) NO WAY IN HELL I'LL EVER LOSE YOU KNOW I'M JOHNNY STUDENTS (SUNG) THE JOHNNY JOHNNY (SUNG) THE ONE THE LADIES NEVER REFUSE. JOHNNY (SUNG) STUDENTS (SUNG) THE TOURNAMENT'S WHERE AHH MY LATEST TRIUMPH WILL RING DING-DONG 'CAUSE WHEN YOU'RE THE JOHNNY STUDENTS (SUNG) THE JOHNNY JOHNNY (SUNG) YOU KNOW THAT YOU'RE THE KING OF HIGH SCHOOL IN CAPE'S BLUFF, CALIFORNIA. AND IT WON'T CHANGE EVER YOU'RE SURE IT'S SO GOOD TO BE ME YES, YOU'RE LOVING THE JOHNNY STUDENTS (SUNG) JOHNNY. JOHNNY (SUNG) YEAH! (The schoolbell rings and ALL disperse.) RUBY Thanks for the introductions, Lanie. LANIE Sure, Ruby, see you around. Hey Kyle, wait up! (SHE runs over to downstage left

(CONT'D) and catches up with Kyle. JOHNNY and BOBBY walk towards the parking lot together. RUBY approaches them.)

RUBY

You're Johnny, right? I'm a new student here, I'm--

BOBBY

Why are you talking to Johnny? He's in tournament mode. You don't want him to lose, do you?

RUBY

No.

BOBBY

Yeah, like you could make Johnny lose. Keep walking, new kid.

(SHE walks away as THEY laugh.)

JOHNNY

You know that girl?

BOBBY

No, but I don't like her. Hey, Johnny, you wanna get some last minute practice in tonight?

JOHNNY Thanks, but I promised Krystal we'd spend a little time together.

> (KRYSTAL, a very hot but mildly trashy girl, enters and plants herself on Johnny's side, kissing him.)

> > BOBBY (A little annoyed)

Hi, Krystal.

(SHE gives BOBBY a little wave.)

BOBBY (CONT'D) You think Weaver's looking for trouble?

JOHNNY (Breaking off from Krystal) I don't think he makes it out of the first round.

BOBBY I mean, by leaning on your car like that.

JOHNNY

What??

(JOHNNY wheels around and sees Kyle and Lanie talking. HE goes to storm off, but BOBBY grabs Johnny by the shoulder.) BOBBY Save it for the tournament. He's not worth it, Johnny. JOHNNY Ease up. We're just gonna talk. (BOBBY lowers his hands. KYLE and LANIE are laughing. JOHNNY goes and pulls Kyle's shoulder back and spins him around.) KYLE What's your problem, Johnny? JOHNNY You think you can just lean on a man's car like that? KYLE Well, it's my car. JOHNNY What? Bobby, it's not my--BOBBY (Calling from a ways off) Yeah, I just realized that, sorry. JOHNNY Our cars don't look anything alike. BOBBY Save it for the tournament. He's not worth it, Johnny. LANIE Looks like you're getting nervous for the tournament. JOHNNY I've never been nervous about anything in my life, nerd herder. Get in the car, Krystal. (SHE shrugs and exits.) KYLE

Can't we put aside our differences, shake hands, and just hope for a good tournament tomorrow?

(HE puts out his hand.)

BOBBY

Save it for the tournament. He's not worth--

JOHNNY

He was just gonna shake my hand, Bobby.

BOBBY

Sorry. I really need glasses, huh?

KYLE

What do you say, Johnny?

(JOHNNY slaps Kyle's hand away.)

JOHNNY

I don't shake hands with losers.

KYLE

Well, I do. So I guess we'll shake after I beat you at the All County Tournament.

JOHNNY

What did you just say?

LANIE

Nice one, Kyle!

JOHNNY

(Pushing him)

You're toast, nerd.

BOBBY (Calling from where HE's standing) He's not worth it, Johnny.

JOHNNY I know, Bobby. Just get in the car, Krystal.

LANIE

I'm not Krystal.

KYLE And Krystal's still in your car.

JOHNNY

Shut up, dweeb. (To Kyle) Listen--

BOBBY Save it for the tournament. He's not worth--

JOHNNY

God, I know, Bobby!

LANIE Look's like somebody's getting rattled. JOHNNY

Krystal, just get--

LANIE Still not Krystal. And she's ...

KYLE Yeah, she hasn't left your car.

JOHNNY

Look, tomorrow, you're dead, dweeb!

(JOHNNY storms off. KYLE and LANIE walks away, leaving BOBBY alone. A beat, then)

BOBBY

He's not worth it, Johnny. He's not.

(Lights down on him and up on a split stage. One one side are KYLE and LANIE outside Mr. M's house. On the other are JOHNNY and KRYSTAL at Johnny's house. JOHNNY and KRYSTAL are making out.)

LANIE One last training session with Mr. M, huh?

KYLE Maybe he's gonna show me how to be a good loser.

LANIE What are you talking about, Kyle? The way you stood up to Johnny today, you've already won.

KYLE

Yeah, I don't know.

LANIE I do. I'll be there cheering you on when you win it all.

KYLE

Thanks, Lanie. For everything. Wish me luck.

(SHE leans in and gives him a soft kiss.)

KYLE (CONT'D)

What was that for?

LANIE

Luck. See you tomorrow.

(THEY part ways and exit. Lights down on

them. Johnny's MOM enters and puts two sodas down in front of Johnny and Krystal.)

MOM

Johnny? Excuse me, Johnny?

(JOHNNY and KRYSTAL break off.)

JOHNNY

What is it, Mom?

MOM

I brought you two some sodas and I wanted to see if you needed anything else.

JOHNNY

A little privacy would be nice.

(Johnny's DAD enters.)

DAD

Johnny, you think you should be up so late the night before a tournament?

JOHNNY

You're right, Dad, maybe if I stay up all night having sex with my girlfriend I won't have the energy to beat everybody else at the tournament. Go home, Krystal.

(SHE gets up sheepishly. DAD and JOHNNY laugh.)

DAD

Good one, son.

JOHNNY Yeah, like I'll really lose tomorrow. Or ever.

(KRYSTAL gets the joke and laughs. SHE sits back down.)

MOM

Are you excited for the tournament, honey?

JOHNNY

Not really, Mom. Just another one in a thousand tournaments. As always, it'll be a snap.

(And with that snap, HE unhooks Krystal's bra. SHE pulls it out through her sleeve. EVERYONE applauds.) That's my boy!

MOM

So talented!

JOHNNY

(Getting up)

All right, I actually am getting tired now. Krystal, you can find a way home, right?

(KRYSTAL shrugs and gets up and goes.)

JOHNNY (CONT'D) See you at the tournament tomorrow.

(Lights down on them and up on an ANNOUNCER with a microphone in a high school gym.)

ANNOUNCER

Welcome, ladies and gentlemen, to the Southern California NHSRPA All-County Tournament. We have a lot of great young athletes here today and I'm sure you're all ready to see this sport the way it was meant to be played. So without any further ado, let's play some ... racquetball!!

(Cheers from the crowd. PLAYER #1 steps forward, racquet in hand.)

"THE TOURNAMENT"

PLAYER #1 (SUNG) THE TOURNAMENT IS MY PLACE TO SHINE TO DRINK FROM THE CUP OF VICTORY TO TASTE ITS SWEET-ASS WINE IT'S DOWN TO THE LAST POINT IT'S JUST HE AND I I GOTTA SEIZE THIS ONE MOMENT CAN'T LET IT PASS ME BY

(PLAYER #2 steps forward, like #1.)

PLAYER #2 (SUNG) THE TOURNAMENT IS MY CHANCE TO SEE THE GARLANDS OF SPLENDOR ATOP MY HEAD TO MAKE MY PARENTS PROUD OF ME IF I HIT IT HARD ENOUGH IF I USE THE RIGHT SPIN MY WHOLE LIFE WILL HAVE A POINT I KNOW THAT I CAN WIN

THE TOURNAMENT

THE TOURNAMENT

PLAYER #1 (SUNG)

THE TOURNAMENT

PLAYER #2 (SUNG)

THE TOURNAMENT

PLAYERS #1 & #2 (SUNG) THE ALL COUNTY TOURNAMENT HERE GOES.

> (Lights up on the whole stage. JOHNNY is next to PLAYER #2 and KYLE is next to PLAYER #1.)

> > ANNOUNCER (SPOKEN, OFF)

Winner, Kyle Weaver. (A pause, then) Winner, Johnny Zabka.

> (The PLAYERS and JOHNNY and KYLE exit. BOBBY and JONATHAN, the angry coach, enter.)

BOBBY (SUNG)

GOTTA BE THE BEST GOTTA PLAY TOUGH GOTTA RULE THE COURT WITH AUTHORITY

JONATHAN (SUNG)

GOTTA COACH 'EM UP GOTTA YELL A LOT JUST TO OVERCOME MY INSECURITY

BOBBY (SUNG)

I KNOW JOHNNY WILL WIN IT ALL BUT I'M GOING FOR A STRONG SECOND PLACE

JONATHAN (SUNG)

AND IF YOU DON'T WIN YOU'LL BRING YOUR FAMILY GREAT DISGRACE.

BOBBY (SUNG) I COULD TRY THE TALLAHASSEE SPIN.

JONATHAN (SUNG) HURRY SO THAT JOHNNY CAN WIN.

BOBBY (SUNG)

THE TOURNAMENT

JONATHAN (SUNG) THE TOURNAMENT BOBBY & JONATHAN (SUNG) THE ALL COUNTY TOURNAMENT ANNOUNCER (SPOKEN, OFF) Winner, Bobby Kove. BOBBY (SUNG) IS MINE. 'TIL I LOSE TO JOHNNY. (KYLE enters.) KYLE (SUNG) ACE THAT SERVE HIT THE DRIVE SERVICE ZONE IT'S JUST YOU AND THE OTHER GUY BUT BASICALLY JUST YOU ALONE. ANNOUNCER (SPOKEN, OFF) Winner, Kyle Weaver. (KYLE exits.) JONATHAN (SPOKEN) Kove, you're up against Weaver. BOBBY (SPOKEN) I'm ready to take him out, Coach. JONATHAN (SPOKEN) Destroy him. BOBBY (SPOKEN) I'll beat that spaz easily. JONATHAN (SPOKEN) I don't want you to win the match. I want you to hurt him. Incapacitate him. Am I understood? BOBBY (SPOKEN) But coach ... it's racquetball. What exactly am I supposed to do? JONATHAN (SPOKEN) Am I understood? BOBBY (SPOKEN) Not really, no.

Good.

(JONATHAN exits. KYLE enters. HE and BOBBY ready for the match. KYLE freezes.)

BOBBY (SUNG)

I WANTED TO GO FURTHER BUT MY DUTY TO JOHNNY CALLS THE TOURNAMENT THE TOURNAMENT THE ALL COUNTY TOURNAMENT HERE'S WHERE THE AXE FALLS.

> (THEY unfreeze. HE goes to serve and BOBBY throws his racquet at Kyle's knee. KYLE goes down.)

ANNOUNCER (SPOKEN, OFF) Disqualification, Bobby Kove.

BOBBY (SPOKEN) I did it for you, Johnny! For you, Johnny!!

(JOHNNY enters.)

JOHNNY (SPOKEN) Sorry, I was in the locker room. What did I miss?

(BOBBY walks out. The ANNOUNCER enters.)

ANNOUNCER (SUNG) WE DIDN'T THINK KYLE WOULD MAKE IT. BUT IT TURNS OUT HE'S OKAY. HE'S AGAINST JOHNNY IN THE FINALS IT'S ALL TIED UP, IT'S SUDDEN DEATH

(JOHNNY & KYLE enter from opposite sides.)

JOHNNY (SUNG)

THE TOURNAMENT

KYLE (SUNG)

THE TOURNAMENT

JOHNNY & KYLE (SUNG) THE ALL COUNTY TOURNAMENT. YOU KNEW IT WOULD END THIS WAY.

ANNOUNCER (SPOKEN, OFF) Final point of the tournament. Ready? Go!

(KYLE goes to serve and all but JOHNNY freeze.)

JOHNNY (SUNG) JUST ONE IN A THOUSAND TOURNAMENTS AND THE WINNER IS ...

(THEY unfreeze. KYLE serves and JOHNNY returns. KYLE jumps, spins in the air and kills the ball. JOHNNY cannot return it. HE falls down.)

ANNOUNCER (OFF) Kyle! Winner, Kyle Weaver!!

JOHNNY & KYLE

What?!?

(Pandemonium. FANS rush Kyle. LANIE and MR. MACKOWEN, Kyle's coach embrace him. JOHNNY is left all alone until KRYSTAL approaches.)

JOHNNY

Krystal, I ... I think I lost.

(KRYSTAL looks shocked. KYLE and his entourage come over to Johnny.)

KYLE

Good match, Johnny.

(KYLE puts out his hand to JOHNNY. JOHNNY slaps it away. KRYSTAL looks at Kyle, then at Johnny, then at Kyle. SHE pushes Lanie out of the way and makes out with Kyle. LANIE is dismayed.)
