The Cleansing

- A. The Message of Forgiveness: God is light in Him is no darkness at all (5)
  - 1. Spiritually
    - a. God is light
    - b. Satan is darkness
  - 2. Morally
    - a. Light is pure/good
    - b. Darkness is corrupt/evil
  - 3. Intellectually
    - a. Light is the truth
    - b. Darkness is a lie
  - 4. The Word is Light/Good/Truth
    - a. Psa. 119:105, 130
    - b. Heb. 6:5
    - c. John 17:17
    - d. Isa. 5:20
- C. The Means of Forgiveness: We attain and maintain communion and cleansing (fellowship and forgiveness) by means of the word/the light/the truth.
  - 1. Communion: But if we walk  $(\leftrightarrow)$  in the light, as he is in the light, we have  $(\leftrightarrow)$  fellowship one with another (7)
  - Cleansing: But if we walk (↔) in the light, as he is in the light, the blood of Jesus Christ his son cleanseth (↔) us from all unrighteousness (7)

The Conditions: Communion and Cleansing (Fellowship and Forgiveness) are Conditional

A. The Principle: We attain and maintain communion and cleansing (fellowship and forgiveness) by means of the word/the light/the truth

B. The Passages: If/Then

a. If: we say that we have fellowship with him, and walk  $(\leftrightarrow)$  in darkness,

Then: we lie  $(\leftrightarrow)$  and do not the truth (6)

- 2. If: we walk  $(\leftrightarrow)$  in the light, as he is in the light,
  - Then: we have  $(\leftrightarrow)$  fellowship one with another,

Then: the blood of Jesus Christ his Son cleanseth  $(\leftrightarrow)$  us from all sin (7).

3. If we say that we have no sin,

Then: we deceive  $(\leftrightarrow)$  ourselves,

Then: the truth is not in us (8)

4. If: we confess  $(\leftrightarrow)$  our sins,

Then: he is faithful and just to forgive  $(\bullet)$  us *our* sins, Then: he is faithful and just to cleanse  $(\bullet)$  us from all unrighteousness (9).

5. If we say that we have not sinned (●) Then: we make him a liar,

Then: his word is not in us (10)
