

# Lighting Tech Position Profile

## Summary

The purpose of this position, under the direction of the Technical Director, is to program and run the lighting cues that enhance the weekend experience.

---

## Big Picture

- Set up lights, cables and equipment as needed for weekend services
- Program lighting cues for both moving and static fixtures
- Run the lighting cues during all three weekend services

---

## Details

### ***Set up lights, cables and equipment as needed for weekend services***

- While the stage lighting hang is generally fixed, some weekends will require additional fixtures, such as the cross light, band lights or other special fixtures
- Working with the TD, select, gel, place, focus and cable these fixtures as needed

### ***Program lighting cues for both moving and static fixtures***

- Using our Hog PC lighting console, develop creative and visually appealing lighting looks that enhance the worship experience
- Ensure that the lighting levels and movements stay within the previously determined CHCC Lighting Guidelines
- Make sure lighting levels properly illuminate the areas needed for both the live audience and video production

### ***Run the lighting cues during all three weekend services***

- Following the run sheet as well as the music, fire cues at appropriate times
- Ensure walk-in and walk-out looks are set before and after services
- Manage haze level to acceptable levels

---

## Qualifications:

- A committed, growing follower of Jesus Christ
- Authentic and consistent in his/her own spiritual walk and relationships
- A desire to learn and understand lighting and color theory, the Hog PC lighting platform and a basic understanding of DMX and lighting control networks
- Ability to follow written and verbal instructions with great attention to detail

## Time Requirements

- For a given weekend, the Lighting Tech will serve from 12:00-6:30 PM on Saturday and from 7:30-12:30 PM on Sunday
- Lighting Tech may serve one or two weekends per month, depending on their availability, desire and schedule

---

## Physical Demands:

The Lighting Tech must possess mobility to work in a stage environment. Specific vision abilities required by this job include vision to read printed material and a computer screen, close and color vision; hearing and speech to communicate in person. The Lighting Tech must also frequently use hands to finger, handle or feel objects, controls. The Lighting Tech must possess mobility to walk up and down a ladder or stairs, and lift up to 50 pounds.
