APOSTROPHES - Level 1 & 2 activities and games

Teaching ideas

These activities make great starter activities. The teacher can assess what students already know and adjust the subsequent input accordingly.

Preparation

- All pages (2-11) are best printed on card and/or laminated.
- Cut pages 4-10 into individual sentence cards. There are 3 sets of sentences one generic, one contextualised to beauty and one contextualised to IT.
- Cut page 11 into individual dominoes.

Apostrophe sentences and smileys (pages 2 – 10)

These are used to practise apostrophes of omission and possession.

- Attach smileys to wall, whiteboard, flip chart or pin board.
- Supply students with blu-tack or pins as appropriate.
- In groups, ask students to pin the sentences onto the correct smiley. I.e. happy = correct, unhappy = incorrect.
- At the end of the session, after some input with examples and rules, students can go back and check their sentences.
- Give students five minutes to change any they are not happy with.
- Finally, go through the results as a whole group.

Apostrophe dominoes (pages 10 - 11)

These are used to practise the apostrophe of omission.

- For a two-player game, start with 7 dominoes each.
- Place remaining dominoes face down in a 'pool'.
- Toss a coin to start. Player 1 places a domino on the table.
- Player 2 places the 'matching' word or words. E.g. if first domino is that's do not the domino placed next to it should contain either that is or don't.
- If the player cannot match either of the words on the domino, they pick up a domino from the pool.
- The player to place all their cards first is the winner.

Other ideas

- You can also play this with four players and no pool, so if a player cannot 'go' the play moves to the next player.
- Alternatively, a small group can work together to make a long chain of dominoes.




