

Finished quilt: 45" x 53" (1.14m x 1.34m)
Finished block size: $81 / 2^{\prime \prime}(21.59 \mathrm{~cm})$ square

## Fabric Requirements:

Note: WOF = Width of Fabric
1/6 YARD OF THE FOLLOWING SKUS:

PWJM081.GREEN PWJM081.PURPL PWJM082.BLUEX PWJM082.PURPL PWJM083.AQUAX PWJM083.PURPL PWJM084.BLUEX PWJM084.ORANG

PWJM084.TEALX PWJM086.GOLDX PWJM086.GREEN PWJM086.REDXX PWJM087.PURPL PWJM088.GREEN PWJM089.PURPL

## $1 ½$ YARD PWJM087.PINKX

(Polka Dot background and outer border.)
$1 \frac{1}{4}$ yard white solid
(background and inner border)
$1 ⁄ 2$ yard PWJM086.GREEN
(Binding)
$3 \frac{1}{4}$ yard ( 42 " wide) OR $15 / 8$ yard ( 60 " wide) backing
52 " x 60 " batting

## Cutting:

From each 1/6 yard print, cut:
(2) $5 " \times 11 "$ rectangle (30 total)

From white yardage, cut:
(15) 5" x 11 " rectangles (Background A)
(4) $2 \frac{1}{2} / 2 \times$ Width of Fabric strips (inner border)

From polka dot yardage (PWJM087.PINKX) cut:
(15) $5 " \times 11 "$ rectangles (Background B)
(5) 5" x Width of Fabric strips (outer border)

## Instructions:

## Blocks:

1. Divide print rectangles into 2 stacks of 15 unique prints.
2. Using one print stack, pair one background A rectangle with one print rectangle, place right sides together. Stitch along the top and bottom of each pair, as shown. Continue until all print rectangles in the stack have been sewn to a background A rectangle. Repeat with the second stack and the background B rectangles. Total (15) Background A matched sets and (15) background B matched sets.

3. Subcut each matched set into (7) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " strips, as shown.


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## Piecing the block:

4. From (22) assorted Background A strips, measure one inch from the top and mark with a disappearing marker or pencil. Cut the WHITE FABRIC ONLY on the marked line. Press seams open to make (22) "A" pieces.

5. Repeat the same technique, marking and cutting the following pieces from the Background A strip sets:
(22) "B" Pieces: Measure $11 / 2$ " from top.
(22) "C" Pieces: Measure 2" from top.
(11) "D" Pieces: Measure $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " from top.

To make (11) "E" Pieces: unpick the top seam, press remaining seam open. Trim $1 / 2$ " from the background end (white or polka dot) so the strip measures $81 / 2$ " $\times 1 \frac{1}{2}$ ".
6. Repeat the above steps to make the following strips from the Background B strips:
(24) "A" Pieces
(24) "B" Pieces
(24) "C" Pieces
(12) "D" Pieces
(12) "E" Pieces

Piece blocks together as shown, pressing seams open.

7. Make (11) Blocks with Background A, and (12) blocks with Background B.
Lay out the quilt as shown, staggering blocks. Rotate blocks so that piece " A " is always at the top.
Piece blocks in rows, press seams open. Sew rows together.
Trim excess as shown.


## To attach borders:

8. Measure sides of quilt, piece border strips as necessary,
measure and cut side borders the same length. Pin, sew, and press toward border. Attach top and bottom borders using the same method. Repeat for the outer border.
Layer, baste, and quilt as desired.
