


OUR STORY

We market seafood we catch on our own boat, the F/V Sandra Lynn, as well as seafood caught by our fishermen friends.



TERMS & CONDITIONS

- 1. By participating in TLC's Summer 2013 CSF, you will receive fresh local seafood once per week at one of our several pick-up locations. (See back panel for current markets.)
- 2. A spending bonus is added onto your weekly allowance. Half-shares will receive a \$1 bonus, totaling \$13 each week. Full shares will receive a \$2 bonus, totaling \$26 each week.
- 3. Pick-up is available only at the time and place that you indicate on your order form. If you know in advance that you will be unable to pick up your share for a particular week, please contact us at (401)-284-1195 or at buyfish@thelocalcatch.com at least 48 hours in advance of your scheduled pick-up.
- 4. If you are unable to personally pick up your share on a particular week, you may ask a friend or family member to pick it up. They must give us your name and sign off on our pick-up sheet, which will be signed each week by all CSF participants upon receiving their weekly share.
- 5. We strongly recommend that you pick up your share within the first two hours of a given market. This ensures maximum choice and availability. If you do not pick up your share by the end of the market and have not notified us at least 48 hours in advance, your share for that week is forfeited.
- 6. In the event of extreme weather that prevents all of our participating boats from going out in a particular week or if markets are canceled, we will extend the CSF season by one week or double up on a subsequent week's share, at our discretion.





- 7. The 2013 CSF Season runs from June 1 September 30. CSF shares provide 12 weeks of fresh seafood. Pick-up dates can be changed with 48 hours advance notice by contacting us at (401)-284-1195 or at buyfish@thelocalcatch.com.
- 8. We commit ourselves to delivering our seafood to you in the freshest state possible. Please ensure that it arrives at your home in the same condition by bringing a cooler or insulated bag with you when picking up your share. We will provide ice for the transport home. Please note, while we do our best, we cannot guarantee every filet is boncless.
- 9. We are not currently able to offer fresh shellfish for sale at all market pickup locations; however, preorders for shellfish on any given pickup week may be placed with at least 48 hours notice of your scheduled pickup. Email shellfish preorders to buyfish@thelocalcatch.com.
- 10. The Local Catch, Inc CSF shares are non-refundable.
