OPIRG is a student-run, campus-based organization focusing on research, education, and action on a wide variety of environmental and social justice issues.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

1. Applicants must attend the Annual General Meeting, to be held on April 4th, 2012.
2. At the Annual General Meeting, applicants are required to introduce themselves to the membership, explain what experience they would bring to the Board of Directors, and describe why they should be elected to sit as a Board Member.
3. Applicants must have had significant involvement with OPIRG Carleton or a similar organization over the last 8 months.
4. Applicants must submit an official nomination form with the signatures of 15 student and/or community members of OPIRG Carleton in good standing.

ABOUT THE POSITION:

1. Each Board seat lasts for a two year term.
2. There are a maximum of 9 Board seats on the Board of Directors.
3. Board Members are required to attend Anti-Oppression, Consensus Decision-Making, and Board Orientation training workshops.
