The Camp Store

As a part of the camp experience, your child will receive one Camp Tomah Shinga t-shirt to take home. There are different style t-shirts, sweatshirts, pens, water bottles, hacky-sacks, bandannas, frisbees, etc. in the Camp Store. The most expensive item is a sweatshirt (\$20) and the cheapest items are \$1-\$2. T-Shirts are usually \$10 and the rest of the items besides sweatshirts are below \$10.



Typically a camper brings along \$10-\$20 to spend during the week and deposits it in the Camp Bank at check-in.

The camp store will also be open when you come to pick up your child from camp.
