BS4800: Selection of colours from BS5252F to be used within paint. Total number of shades: approx. 100

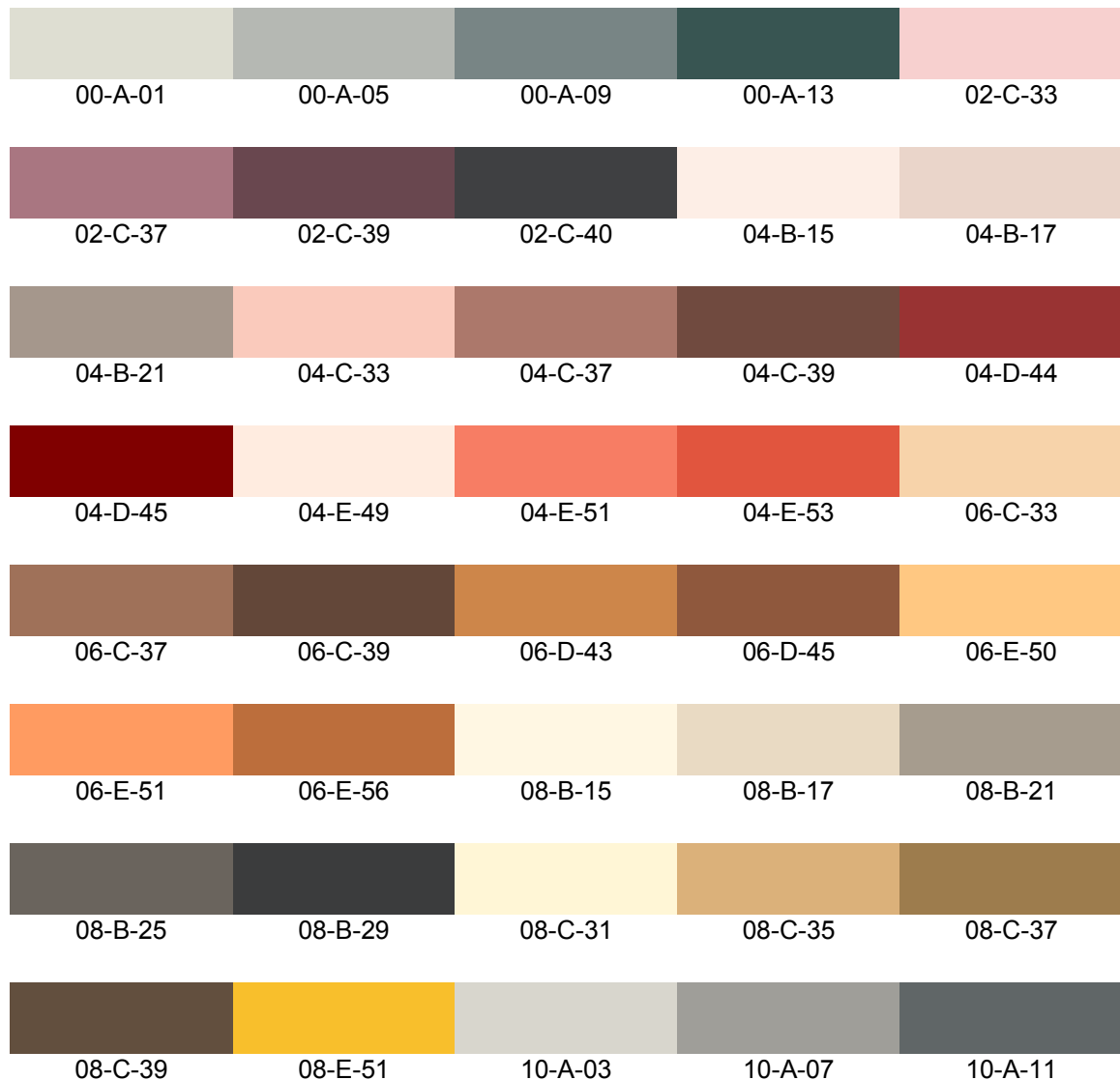
Typical notation: 08B15 How to understand the notation:

08 indicate hue (groups from 00 to 24)

B indicate greyness group (groups from A to E)

15 saturation (groups from 01 to 58)
