This January, we will be having another Confirmation class during Sunday School time. We are excited to have Zachary Langdon, Nathan Middaugh, and Drew Blaydes taking part in the study and instruction for church membership. I find Confirmation to be a special time to get to know our youth and faith-strengthening experience! Our theme will be "In Life and in Death, we belong to God." Reflect on these questions along with our confirmands.

Sunday, January 5, we will be talking about the Lord's Supper and then experiencing it in worship. How does Communion strengthen you in life? What promises does it give you in death?

Sunday, January 12, we will be discussing Baptism and then experiencing it in our Baptism Remembrance Sunday. How do we 'die' in baptism? How do we live a new life in Jesus?

Sunday, January 19, will be about Christian fellowship and study. On Monday, January 20 at 7pm, everyone is encouraged to go to the Community Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. Service at St. Matthew AME. What does community mean to us in life? What does it mean to us in death?

On February 2, we will celebrate Confirmation Sunday with our young folks.
