Please note we do include a link to the font. However, due to copyright laws we can not include font files in the products.

Editing colors: Changing colors is simple! Simple double click on the layer and the color selector will pop up. Select the color you would like to use. You can also hide or un-hide layers for new/different looks. Another option is to change the blend modes.

Editing Text Layers: Text layers are sent to you in the font used on the design. If the font is not installed on your computer you will not be able to use it and Photoshop will substitute with a similar font.

Working with photo layers: There are several methods for adding your images to the templates. One of the easiest is the "Place" method. First make sure you click the "Photo Frame" layer on your card. Next go to the File menu in Photoshop. Click the "Place" option. Find the image on your hard drive and select it. Photoshop will resize the image so it fits on the card. You will probably have to adjust the size further. You can do this by pressing ⌘ t (mac) or ctrl t (pc) for the free transform tool. You will see your photo gets the "handle bars" on the corners. You can adjust the size by dragging the corners. Make sure you hold the shift key while you are doing this so the image does not become distorted! If you loose the layer mask in the process simply press ⌘ alt G (mac) or ctrl alt G (pc).
