
Grammy-winning "Ambrosia," frontman and guitarist David Pack Releases Napa Crossroads on Concord Records

"Silverado Free" features the late and great Ry Manzarek on keyboards and included his trademark Vox organ sound. "He heard the final version, emailed back and said, 'I love it," Pack said of Manzarek's key role in the production.

According to Pack Concord Records came on board towards the end of the project. The wineries put up production money and Pack invested five years of his time traveling back and forth from Southern Cali to Napa to write and produce."We just let it organically happen," says David Pack. "David's concept of bringing together the art of songwriting with the art of making wine defines Napa Valley and what we are all about. To see his dream come true and be a part of it is truly awesome," says Jeff Gargiulo owner of Gargiulo Vineyards. His songs, "April Born in May" and "Wine Country Cowboy" were inspired by his daughter and Jeff and David Duncan's band The Silverado Pickups.
