Achieving Personalized Instruction and Customizing Distance Learning

Virtual Learning Academy Charter School

In July 2013, the Virtual Learning Academy Charter School was awarded a Next Generation Learning Challenge grant to implement a breakthrough college-readiness model. The model provides students and families with the opportunity to radically personalize learning by creating individualized learning that reflect their particular interests and goals.

Students earn competencies through a variety of learning pathways, including independent studies, projects, internships, work experiences, online courses, face-to-face courses, hobbies, service learning, or a combination of activities. Students who participate in these learning experiences will find that there is no prescribed way or timeline for earning a competency; there is just the way that works best for the student.
