

### The value of encyclopedias

**Q:** At auction years ago, I bought an oil on canvas painting by Oliver Houston that shows a Pilgrim family sitting down to a Thanksgiving dinner. How old is it, and does it have value? —

*Cindy, cybercollector*

**A:** The only Oliver Houston with auction records was a California painter known for his 1930s marine scenes, many with battle-

ships. Since California art and artists are hot, check with a regional auction house—if intent is to sell. Or they can suggest an appraiser for the work.

If the artist is the one known for marine scenes, an atypical subject would sell for less.

**Q:** We are qualified appraisers with expertise. You mislead readers when you suggest they try to sell old encyclopedias online. You should tell readers when

items have no commercial value.

—*Pauline, Tucson, Arizona*

**A:** The query at issue was for a vintage Funk & Wagnalls set of encyclopedias. My response was that they have no value, but the reader could post on eBay or in a similar online auction and see if anything happens.

According to eBay, over \$1,640 million in goods are traded every second, worldwide. Posting a single book for under \$10 costs just a quarter. If just one online buyer seeks a single volume to round out a set, the reader could make a sale. My response stands.

**Beer Battered Shrimp**

■ *In a homemade cocktail sauce*

Dear Ask Annie,

Do you have a recipe for shrimp made with beer batter? My Bingo friend, Sue Ann, thinks this is the only way to eat shrimp. She and her hubby are coming for dinner over the holidays and I want to surprise her with this shrimp.

*LuAnn from Reno, Nevada*

Dear LuAnn,

Here's an easy recipe for BEER BATTERED SHRIMP. I suggest serving your shrimp with a peach jam in addition to serving cocktail sauce. It's a great alternative as a shrimp sauce. I hope Sue Ann is impressed. Enjoy! —Annie

**BEER BATTERED SHRIMP**

- 2 pounds large shrimp
- 2 cups flour
- 1 teaspoon lemon pepper seasoning
- 1 egg
- 1 1/2 cups beer
- Oil for frying

Using a large saucepan or frying pot, preheat the oil to 375 degrees (use a frying thermometer). Shell and clean the shrimp.

Lightly mix the flour, lemon pepper seasoning, egg and beer. Do not over mix. Dip the shrimp in the batter and then deep-fry until lightly browned. Drain and serve with cocktail sauce or a sweet and sour sauce. Serves 4 to 6.

Dear Annie,

How do I make cocktail sauce at home?

Dear Austin,

I combine one cup of chili sauce (Heinz is my favorite brand) and a teaspoon of prepared horseradish.

Add more or less horseradish according to your tastes. My Mother taught me this recipe over 50 years ago. I was just a child at the time. —Annie

■ *New World Bingo Grand Champion Crowned*

Eight years ago, Lorelei "Lori" Polster and her husband, Willy, decided to celebrate their wedding anniversary by taking their first-ever cruise vacation.

Being from Henderson, Nevada, and no strangers to the Bingo rooms of Las Vegas, the Polsters chose the World Championship Bingo Tournament & Gaming Cruise because it combined their love of Bingo with a first-class tropical cruise adventure. "We also liked that it came right after our anniversary, which is in October," Lori says. "It was like it was tailor made for us."

The Polsters enjoyed the trip immensely, particularly after Lori won \$700 in the Bingo Tournament. "The whole trip was great and we decided we would go again," Lori says. "But we felt going every year was a bit extravagant and decided to go every other year." 2011 was the Polsters' fourth Bingo Bugle cruise.

"We joked that we wished that one card had been mine so it would have taken us over the top," Lori says. "But honestly, I was very happy with \$1,200 and was thrilled with \$2,400, and Willy's \$600 was a bonus. We were ready to head home very happy about our winnings."

But the winning wasn't over yet. A handful of games later, Lori got her wish—winning her own split pot and adding another \$600 to her total. This moved her squarely in the lead with the most money won. By the end of the tournament no one had matched her winning total, and Lori became the newest World Bingo Grand Champion.

"There was a great rush to get me down from the balcony and to the stage," Lori says. "I was presented with another \$5,000 and the championship trophy. It was amazing. I mean, I've never been a world champion anything before. Now I am!"

Lori Polster is the Bingo Bugle's newest tournament champion, but she won't be the last. A new crown is being polished and ready for our next winner—in the 2012 World Championship Bingo Tournament & Gaming Cruise setting sail Nov. 3 and visiting the idyllic eastern Caribbean.




## Good Housekeeping

### Coconut Rice Pudding

A popular dessert in the Caribbean. Our recipe takes just 15 minutes to prepare. The slow cooker does the rest.

- 2 3/4 cups water
- 3/4 cup long-grain white rice
- 1 can (15 ounces) cream of coconut (not coconut milk)
- 1 can (12 ounces) evaporated milk
- 2/3 cup sweetened, flaked coconut (optional)
- 1 tablespoon dark rum (optional)

1. In 4 1/2- to 6-quart slow-cooker bowl, stir water, rice, cream of coconut and evaporated milk until combined. Cover slow cooker with

lid and cook as manufacturer directs on low setting 4 to 5 hours or on high setting 2 1/2 to 3 hours.

2. If you like, while pudding cooks, toast coconut: Heat nonstick small skillet over medium heat until hot.

Add coconut; cook 4 to 5 minutes or until lightly browned, stirring constantly. Transfer coconut to plate.

3. Remove bowl from slow cooker. Stir in rum, if using. Let pudding stand 10 minutes. Transfer pudding to serving bowl. If not serving right away, press sheet of plastic wrap onto pudding; refrigerate up to 2 days.

4. To serve, spoon pudding into dessert bowls; sprinkle with toasted coconut if using.




**Gulf War Illness**

Baylor University researchers sought to compare the illnesses of veterans with the conditions of their actual deployment. Reported in the Environmental Health Perspectives September 2011 issue, *Complex Factors in the Etiology of Gulf War Illness* takes a look at veterans who served in Gulf War I back in 1990-1991.

The report says that one-fourth of Gulf War I veterans have pain, memory problems, gut and breathing problems, mood problems and headaches—illnesses that are grouped together and called Gulf War Illness, or GWI. The types of illnesses depend on the location served and subgroups of those locations have been identified.

For example, certain illness in veterans who served in Iraq or Kuwait are likely due to the pills given as a nerve gas antidote. Veterans who weren't necessarily on the front lines were subjected to pesticides,

with worse effects if their uniforms were treated with pesticides or they also wore flea collars. Those in Kuwait were exposed to oil-well fires. Everyone got multiple vaccines.

Researchers used questionnaires and got down to map level, along the lines of, "Where you were? What was your role? How long were you there?" Participants were asked about each of 19 different experiences, such as, whether they had actual contact with destroyed enemy vehicles or were within 1 mile of a SCUD missile.

Bottom line: It depends where you were and what you were doing. If you have a so-far undiagnosed illness, this research can be helpful in establishing a claim with the VA. To find the whole document (not just the Abstract) put the whole title in Google—"Complex Factors in the Etiology of Gulf War Illness"—and click the "More" menu at the top, then select "Documents."

**Drug-Free Headache Relief**

If you have a headache, you may want to visit a doctor of chiropractic care before you head to the medicine cabinet. Doing so can speed relief and help you avoid the side effects associated with certain drugs.

A report from the Duke University Evidence-Based Practice Center in Durham, N.C., found that spinal manipulation quickly improved headaches originating in the neck, and had far fewer side effects and longer-lasting relief of tension headaches than a commonly prescribed medication.

Other studies have shown chiropractic care to be effective in the treatment of migraine headaches. "Headaches can often be debilitating and deserve examination by a doctor," explains Gerard Clum, D.C., a spokesperson for the not-for-profit Foundation for Chiropractic Progress (FCP).

"The migranes could be a warning sign that something is wrong. That something wrong could be a structural problem with the head and neck as a result of posture or injury."

As such, a whole process of petitioning, getting Bingo sponsors to support your cause, getting local politicians behind you, holding hearings, executing impact studies, etc., is required. And all that is simply to get consideration and may not necessarily mean an increase will be approved.

Needless to say, it's quite an undertaking—and explains why I am always stunned when I hear that a state has increased its prize pay-

outs, and incredibly impressed with the people in the background who made it happen. —*Guy*

### Hi Guy,





### Indian Bingo Sees Expansion

Significant progress has been made on Michigan-based FireKeepers Casino's expansion the Nottawaseppi Huron Band of the Potawatomi reports. Construction began in May in preparation for the raising of an eight-story, 242-room hotel just west of the casino, in Emmett Township. The expanded

facility will open this fall. Plans include increasing amenities, gaming space, entertainment and dining options to the facility that opened in August 2009. The hotel is expected to feature an indoor pool, exercise facility, restaurant and business center. A multi-purpose event center is expected to seat more than 2,000 guests in a concert setting, and may be configured to accommodate banquets, weddings, corporate meetings, trade shows, and other events. In addition, Bingo operations will be expanded to 10,000-square-feet, doubling the capacity from 250 players to 500 per session.

### Survey On Luck

William Hill Bingo commissioned a survey on luck which revealed that 69% of the nation believed in luck while 31% did not. The survey also looked at a regional breakdown of the luckiest people in the country. People in Northern Ireland certainly believe in the luck of the Irish, with 62.5% of respondents saying they are convinced they are lucky. Only 29% of Scots believe they get any luck. People from the Northwest, Northeast, Yorkshire, and the Midlands don't class themselves as lucky, but the Welsh (55.3%), Londoners (54.2%) and Easterners (52.2%), class themselves in the lucky bracket. The poll also revealed that Great Britain is a superstitious nation, with 57.5% of Brits adhering to superstitions. Just under 40% of the population won't walk under ladders, 30% won't reveal their birthday wish after blowing out their candles, and 8.7% would bring a lucky charm into an interview or exam.

### Illegal Bingo Shut Down

A group of five Indiana residents have been charged in a \$1 million charity Bingo scam. According to the Fort Wayne, Indiana, *Journal Gazette*, the suspects—four men and one woman—ran Bingo games that were supposed to be for charity at an American Legion Post, but investigators believe they skimmed between \$988,000 and \$1,040,000 from the games over the past five years. The woman, who allegedly managed the Bingo games, and her husband, who was post trustee, reportedly face various felony charges including theft and unlawful charity gaming contracting. Another Bingo manager and finance officers linked to the post allegedly face similar charges.





John is one of my favorite Bingo Buddies. He is a giant of a man who is as gentle as a butterfly. "Big people, especially men, have to be careful," he says, "or we end up as bullies, scaring the smaller ones. I weighed 140 pounds when I entered kindergarten. I wasn't as tall, but I outweighed the teacher." Playing Bingo is John's favorite hobby, but he doesn't get to play very often. He is a computer

genius whose huge hands rest lightly on the keys. A consultant and troubleshooter, he is often called out at strange hours to fix a complicated computer problem that can't wait. He has even been called out of Bingo games to rescue a customer whose system has crashed. "My size seems to reassure people who have trouble," says John. "It's as if I can go forth and slay the dragons of cyberspace." John has a laugh that exactly fits his size. He booms and guffaws. When he has a Bingo, he doesn't just win, he claims victory over all the forces of chance. He shouts and pounds the table and involves everybody in his triumph. He turns to someone else at the table and says, "Sorry you didn't win, fella. I guess it was just my turn." Then his infectious laugh encircles all those around him and

it is impossible not to celebrate with him. I am surprised John isn't married but Kate says she understands completely. "Who could keep up with him? He is full of energy and besides he's a great cook and housekeeper." Once in awhile he brings a date to Bingo and she is nearly always a small person who seems timid and often overwhelmed. Most of the time, however, he comes alone and creates a party around himself. He brings homemade cookies for sharing, as his spirit is as generous as his size. Last week as we played a late night game, John unexpectedly bounced wildly in his chair and it collapsed under him, spilling him to the floor. All of us around him were terrified at the loud crash and for his bulk being so suddenly thrown down. "Call 911," someone shouted. "Don't move him," came

another distressed suggestion. "Get a lawyer," said a player nearby. Kate pushed her way through the other players and knelt by John's side. "He seems to be having some kind of seizure," she said softly to me. "Help me roll him over." We struggled, determined not to hurt him further while trying to give aid. "Perhaps we should put him face down," I said. "I've heard that helps if someone is having a fit." "Don't be dumb," replied Kate. "Just help me." As gently as possible we hefted his bulk until we could see his face. He was shaking with laughter and at first could not speak. Then he sat up, wiped tears from his face and said, "Oh my, that was a flat out, fall on the floor win. I've got a Bingo!"



### Handicap spaces

■ *Be sensitive and be aware*

#### Dear Aunt Bingo,

Last night I took my husband to Midnight Bingo. We leave early so we can find handicap parking. There are usually two, maybe four, places marked with wide stripes. These are for wheelchairs only and have a wheelchair picture and van-accessible sign on them. Unfortunately, there are few people who understand or give a d— about anyone else. When we arrived at the Bingo all lined parking (two spots) was gone, so I had to take up two parking spaces. (The hall owner had told us it was OK to do this when the handicap spaces were full.)

My husband has no legs and is in a wheelchair. We have a ramp that folds out and lies on the ground. He then rolls

down and has to have additional room to clear the end of the ramp with his chair. Our van has a sign on the door that says, "Wheelchair: Leave 8 Feet Clearance." Yet in spite of all this, when we came out of Bingo there was a little car that had wedged itself into the space next to our van, making it impossible for my husband to get in.

I could have let my ramp down a few times on top of her car and really done some damage to the hood. I refrained from doing so, but it took a lot of restraint.

They were still playing the pull-tab games in the hall and we had to wait for 30 minutes for this inconsiderate lady to move her car. I found out later that the driver had complained to the security guard that I had taken two parking spaces. Unfortunately, the guard did not have the sense to tell her to move her car, although he did point out to her the sign saying to leave eight feet for clearance.

This has not happened to us just at Bingo. We have had similar problems at department stores and other places with public parking lots.

Thank you for letting me vent. Maybe some people will be more considerate of those who are living lives with disabilities. —*Kay from Texas*

#### Dear Kay,

I have relatives who are wheelchair bound and I have seen firsthand the amount of space necessary to operate a van chairlift. I have also witnessed how difficult it can be to maneuver these vans into tight parking lots and even tighter handicap spaces.

The *Miami Herald* reports that Walmart is selling tickets in 27 of its Neighborhood Market locations in what is considered a pilot program. The deal began with stores in Pinellas Park, Largo, Clearwater, Pompano Beach, Plantation, Coral Springs and Orlando, with other stores rolling out sales afterward. Customers can buy scratch-offs and drawing games, including Powerball, Florida Lotto, Fantasy 5, Play

I read in your column about someone whose mother-in-law left and gave her packet to her and she won but they wouldn't pay her because it was called splitting the packet.

To me, people split Bingo packages all the time. I notice that couples do it all the time. One gets the seat while the other goes and buys the packages for them. Well, that is splitting because the other person didn't go and buy the package themselves. So it's actually done all the time and when they win they are paid. #### Maryland Lotto Teams with Amber Alert

The next time someone in Maryland stops by their local convenience store to buy a scratch-off or a Powerball, they may become the lead police often hope for after a child is abducted.

DelmarvaNow.com reports that the Maryland Lottery Agency and the Maryland State Police have teamed up to issue Amber Alerts on the 17-inch flat panel color monitors that occupy about 3,700 locations throughout Maryland where lottery tickets are bought and sold. Once an alert is issued, information should be posted on the system, which is monitored 24 hours a day, within

4, Cash 3 and Lucky Lines. "By expanding our retail footprint, we're able to sell more tickets, which in turn raises more money for education programs in the state," O'Connell said in a press release.

#### Trip Through Europe Delays Lottey Claim

Craig Henshaw was a multi-millionaire for two months and didn't even know it. The 42-year-old high school woodworking teacher was too preoccupied staying in hostels in Paris and couch surfing in Ireland and Vienna with his girlfriend, reported CNews Canada. It was only when he arrived home in Toronto and checked the LottoMax ticket that he realized he was \$21.4 million richer. "I wouldn't have lived out of a backpack for two months if I knew I had \$21 million sitting on my fridge at home," Henshaw said. He plans on paying for his two nieces and his nephew's tuitions when they grow up, get rid of some student loans for a few friends and take his family on holiday.

#### Virginia Lotto Joins Facebook

The Virginia Lottery now is streaming its drawings live on its Facebook page, in addition to its Web site. In order to view the live video stream on the Virginia Lottery Facebook page, visitors must first click the "Like" option on the page, according to a lottery news release. The live streams can be viewed daily at 1:59 and 11:00 p.m. Viewers can watch the Pick 3, Pick 4, and Cash 5 drawings, and also can watch the Mega Millions drawings on Tuesday and Friday nights. Powerball and Win for Life can be viewed on Wednesday and Saturday nights and the Decades for Dollars can be seen on Monday and Thursday nights.
