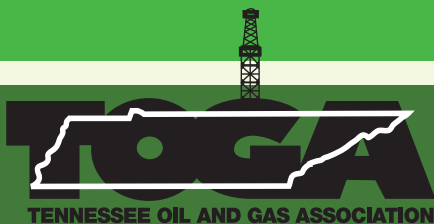

Bob Kesling, Director of Broadcasting/ Play-by-Play Announcer **Vol Network**

Bob Kesling was named the University of Tennessee Director of Broadcasting and lead play-by-play voice of the Vol Network in July of 1999. Kesling is the radio play-by-play announcer for Tennessee football and basketball on 70 plus station Vol Network. He is the host of the Butch Jones TV show on the Vol Network and does play-by-play for Tennessee baseball and Lady Vol basketball on the Vol Television Network. Kesling serves as the host for the Vol Network's weekly hour long state-wide radio call-in show Vol Calls and the Big Orange Hotline during the football season.

Kesling began his association with the University of Tennessee as a walk-on fullback on the 1972 freshman football team. He began his broadcasting career while a student at Tennessee in 1974 as a film editor on the Bill Battle TV Show working for John Ward. In 1976 he joined the Vol Network as a pre and post game host and served as John Ward's spotter. Kesling spent 15 years sitting next to the legendary "Voice of the Vols" as his spotter and working on Vol Network broadcasts.

After graduation from the University of Tennessee, Kesling held the sports director job at WIVK radio and then moved on to television at WBIR where he worked until 1999 when he resumed his career with the Vol Network.

He is a four time winner of the Sportscaster of the Year in the State of Tennessee. Active in the community, Kesling serves on the board of directors for Goodwill, the YMCA and the Knoxville Sports Hall of Fame. Each year he hosts a celebrity golf tournament in Greeneville, TN. to benefit the Boys and Girls Club of Greene Co.

Dr. Gary Bible and Tamia Cloud Bible (CPA) formed Cougar Dome, LLC: Geology and GIS Consulting in March of 2013. Dr. Bible drilled his first successful wildcat well as a trainee geologist. He has an 86% career success rate on wells that he has drilled with Phillips Petroleum Company, Alamco, Inc., and Miller Energy Resources. Domestically, in his 35 year career, Dr. Bible has worked in the Appalachian, Anadarko, Big Horn, Black Warrior, Dallas-Ft. Worth, Denver-Julesburg, Paradox, and Williston Basins, as well as Alaska and the Gulf Coast of the U. S. Internationally, Dr. Bible has done Landsat and basin studies on the Tsaidam and Sichuan Basins in mainland China. He has also done geological field work in

New Guinea, as well as Landsat and field work in Thailand.

Dr. Bible drilled 254 wells from 1978 through present, of which 218 were successful, an 86% career success rate. He has an 87% development well success rate (196 out of 226) and a 79% exploration well success rate (22 out of 28). While at Miller Energy Resources, Dr. Bible pioneered horizontal drilling in the Mississippian Age Fort Payne Formation by drilling the first two successful horizontal water-free oil wells in that formation in North America. Dr. Bible discovered fourteen new fields in Tennessee and Kentucky from 1991-present. He also assisted in establishing the first commercial coal bed methane (CBM) field in Kentucky while at Miller and is an Adjunct Professor in the Earth and Planetary Sciences Department of the University of Tennessee.

Dr. Robert Hatcher is a tectonics and structural geologist with over 40 years of experience in Appalachian tectonics, the comparative tectonics of other mountain chains, and the geology of Central and East Tennessee and adjacent states. Dr. Hatcher has been employed in the public and private sectors throughout his career as a geologist, consultant and instructor.

Dr. Hatcher has been involved in hydrocarbon assessment and interpretation of geology for developing exploration models for many years in the southern Appalachians (e.g., Hatcher, 1982). He has also been directly involved for many years with geophysicists in interpretation of potential field (gravity and aeromagnetic) and aeroradioactivity data from the Appalachian and other regions (Hatcher and Zietz, 1980; Hatcher et al., 1979; Hatcher et al., 1981; Hatcher et al., 2004), and in the acquisition and interpretation of seismic reflection data (Cook et al., 1979; Costain et al., 1989; Hatcher et al., 1994, 2001; Whisner and Hatcher, 2003; McBride et al., 2005). He served as Chief Scientist for the NSF-supported Appalachian Ultradeep Core Hole Site Investigation from 1983-1987, coordinating the work of geologists and geophysicists from the University of South Carolina, Virginia Tech, Stanford, Columbia (Lamont-Doherty), Princeton, and Penn State Universities. He was the recipient of the 2006 American Geological Institute Ian Campbell Medal and the Geological Society of America Penrose Medal, and is the 2014 recipient of the American Geological Institute Marcus Milling Legendary Geoscientist Medal.

Dr. Hatcher received a B.A. degree from Vanderbilt University in 1961 and M.S. degree from Vanderbilt University in 1962. He received his Ph.D. from the University of Tennessee in 1965.
