Bursary Fund

YAS annually receives grants and tax-deductible donations to its bursary fund. Awards from the YAS Bursary Fund assist those who cannot afford all their YAS fees. Since 1996, over \$330,000.00 in YAS bursaries has been awarded. A bursary inquiry must be made by a parent, grandparent or guardian of the player(s) who wishes to enroll in YAS camp or camps and who requires financial assistance. A bursary inquiry should be made as far as possible in advance of the camp(s) of interest. Bursary inquiries and awards are handled only by the YAS Camps Director and are completely confidential.

Throughout each day you'll receive mini-mentoring about the importance of physical fitness and healthy nutrition.

At each day's end you'll have a chance to win in prize draws.

Who's Eligible?

Every graduate of a YAS 2013 camp held in Regina or Saskatoon is eligible play in this tournament and to bring one or two guests if they wish. Guest(s) must be under age 17 or under age 13 as of July 1st and not have attended any summer sports camp or school during July or August 2013.
