16 years ago entrepreneur Philippe Kahn connected a point and shoot camera to his mobile phone. His first image was of his baby daughter.


FAST FORWARD





TOP 10 TIPS

- 1. Steady hand
- 2. Lock off exposure
- 3. Full size images
- 4. Keep the lens clean
- 5. Avoid the onboard flash
- 6. Good lighting
- 7. Don't zoom walk in
- 8. Back up x 2 at least
- 9. Use new angles
- 10. Share and engage
