Efficient companies use RIM programs to identify important information, provide for quick retrieval of that information, and dispose of information with no ongoing business value. The ability to find information when it is needed can streamline processes, make workers more efficient, and provide for timely and meaningful project collaboration.

It used to be that file clerks and secretaries were tasked with organizing and filing important papers. Today, however, **all employees** are responsible for managing not only paper records, but an ever increasing volume of electronic records.

Just as IT departments know the hardware and software on which data resides, professional records managers have the expertise to develop policies, procedures and training to guide employees in managing one of the company's most important assets, records and information.

Today's information exists in many forms, lives in many places, and is highly mobile. For instance, along with traditional paper documents, electronic information may be created as email, web forms, tweets and posts, texts, application data, office documents, voicemail, databases, and more. It lives in cabinets, boxes, hard drives, servers (cloud & on-premise), microfilm, CDs, thumb drives, smartphones, tablets and the like; and it can all be sent around the world instantaneously with the click of a button.

Additionally, laws and regulations dictate that sensitive and other personally identifiable information about employees, customers and clients must be safeguarded. They dictate what must be kept and for how long. The ramifications for failing to meet these requirements can be severe – and they change continuously. RIM helps to manage these processes.

Austin ARMA was established in 1990 and is dedicated to serving the ARMA members of Austin, Texas and the surrounding area.

As the local chapter of ARMA International, the professional association for records and information management practitioners, Austin ARMA has over 140 members who are drawn from many different disciplines including government, technology, legal, retail, utilities, medical, engineering, manufacturing, higher education and historical preservation.
