The powerful sound of Japanese taiko drums—once used to mark the limits of a shrine parish—have captured the imagination of new artistic ensembles and community groups around the world.

Two leading artists in the genre—Kenny Endo, a pioneer in taiko ensemble in North America and composer, and Kaoru Watanabe, former member of the world-famous Kodo ensemble—will provide a short lecture, followed by a performance.
