Nancy Hascall has taught and conducted at regional and national handbell events throughout the U.S. and Canada, as well as International Handbell Symposiums in Australia and England. She tours nationally as a handbell solo artist and originated the system of techniques known as traveling four-in-hand, which facilitates her fluid ringing style. Nancy provides private coaching for both groups and individuals, including destination 3-day private solo ringing tutorials at her home near Portland, Oregon. Three of Nancy's compositions have been per-

formed at Distinctly Bronze events, and her "Andromeda" won the 2002 Bells of the Sound Composition Contest. Nancy directs the Sanctuary Bells of First United Methodist Church in Portland, and recently retired from Bells of the Cascades after 14 years as its musical director. She still rings in the Covenant Bell Choir at Lake Grove Presbyterian Church, where she first picked up a handbell in 1979.

Tonight Nancy will perform Siciliene, by Gabriel Faure which she has arranged for solo handbells, keyboard, and cello. Nancy will also perform a duet-"Symphonia on Hyfrydol", arranged by Kevin McChesney - with Pennsylvania's own Sue Garton, another solo handbell artist known nationally for her ringing skills and excellent teaching methods. Sue lives in Slippery Rock, PA.

The third small ensemble piece will be performed by Bronze Expressions, a handbell quartet from St. Paul's United Methodist Church, Elizabethtown, PA. They had such fun playing this piece on Easter morning that they asked to perform it for us tonight.
