Two years after the project began, 20 fans breathed life into the league by taking part in our inaugural fantasy hockey season. As we begin our second year, I thought it appropriate to take a look back at how we got where we are and what happened during that inaugural season.

From the Ground Up...

The project was announced as “From the Ground Up” on Aug. 10, 2008. In that blog post, plans were laid out for Icethetics’ biggest undertaking to date. Designing an entire hockey league from scratch would be an arduous process, but readers would be able to give their input in every decision made, every step of the way.

NORTH AMERICA OR THE WORLD?

After 69% of readers showed an interest in moving forward with the project, they were asked how the geography of the league should be defined. There were 1,450 votes cast during the weeklong poll and 59% chose a North American league over a global one.

HOW MANY TEAMS?

Voters were given the following options: 24, 27, 30, 32 or 36 teams for the new league. The poll, which began Aug. 18, finished with 1,186 votes cast, 34% choosing a 30-team league.

THE DIVISIONAL ALIGNMENT

On Aug. 24, a poll was opened to determine how the North American continent should be divided up for cities to be assigned teams. Voters were given five options. The following alignment received the most votes with 33% of the 2,208 participants selecting it.

Selecting Cities

On Aug. 30, 2008, the league still lacked a name but it was full steam ahead as Icethetics readers began selecting the cities that would eventually host its 30 teams. In each of the six divisions, voters chose from 12 eligible cities. The top five in each were awarded franchises.

The readers who originally suggested the names that would eventually be selected have each been recognized here for the first time. Hundreds of names were nominated by hundreds of readers over several weeks. Ultimately, it was the user ratings that created the league that would be named the IceHL on Sept. 21, 2008.

LOGO DESIGN COMPETITION

Icehetics has always been a haven for artists with new ideas for hockey logo and uniform design. At the center of their artistic endeavors has been the NHL, an organization very protective of its identity and that of its member clubs. Because of this, some of the most talented creative forces contributing to the site could never do more than put their work on display for fellow readers to admire.

They couldn't really "own" it. Time for a change.

In part, the goal of the IceHL Project was to give Icehetics artists a creative outlet that wouldn't infringe upon the legal property of another. They would add color and life to ideas generated by their community. Their work would be admired in a completely new and different way.

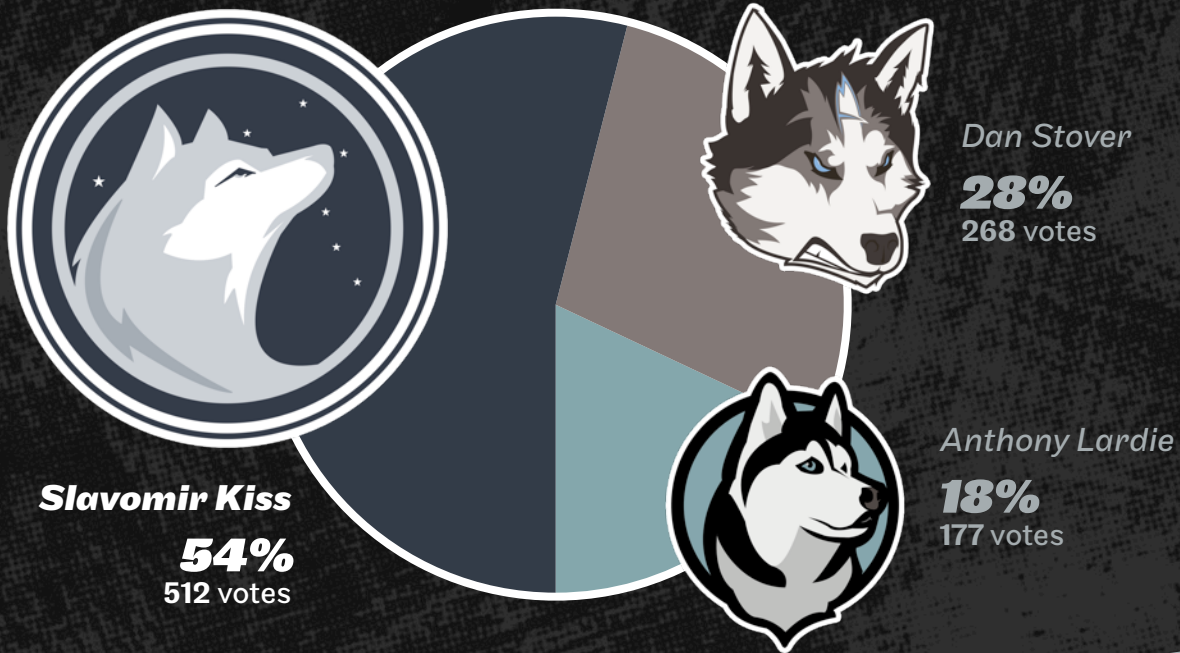
On Sept. 21, 2008, Icehetics began accepting artwork to be considered to represent the 30 teams that had been created, one division at a time. Those interested were given three weeks from the date of each division's announcement to develop and submit a visual brand to be voted upon by the community.

They were required to provide a primary mark, a secondary mark and a wordmark that could be used to uniquely identify an IceHL franchise. Dozens of designers entered outstanding work into the competition, which held no promise of a prize. They did it solely to be recognized by their peers for their talents.

The following pages of the **IceHL 2011 YEARBOOK** pay tribute the winning designs and honor those that fell just shy of the mark.

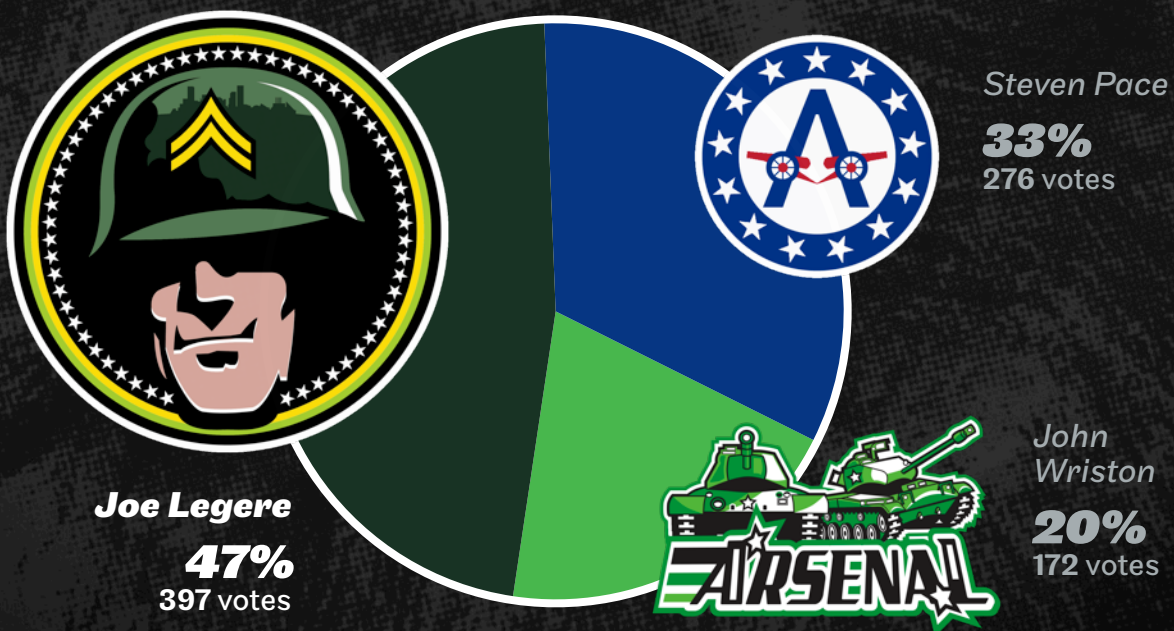

FANTASY LEAGUE

In the fall of 2009, a year after it began, the IceHL Project was put on hiatus. An overly complex uniform design competition helped lead to a diminished interest from readers in moving forward.

The IceHL section of Icethetics collected dust for almost another year before it was revived with a new goal in mind. The IceHL was intended as an artistic exercise from the outset. It was not initially meant to be a true fantasy league in which GMs drafted and traded NHL players while collecting stats.

But that didn't mean it couldn't be.

At the urging of a few enthusiastic readers, I decided to start an online fantasy league centered on IceHL teams. Icethetics readers could sign up to manage a team for the season, breathing a new kind of life into the project. The idea was much more popular than I had imagined.

In just a few days, more than 100 users signed up to join a league that, due to ESPN.com restrictions, could only have 20 teams. Owners were then selected at random and assigned the IceHL teams of their choice. They had a wide variety of fantasy hockey backgrounds, from the greenest rookies to the most experienced veterans. From my seat as IceHL Commissioner, it was huge fun to be a part of.

The following pages of the ***IceHL 2011 YEARBOOK*** recount the inaugural season of IceHL fantasy hockey. Each team page features the team's complete branding identity and details of its season including a draft recap and final roster.

2010-11 IceHL Season



The IceHL online fantasy league was announced on Sept. 27, 2010, just 10 days before the start of the NHL season. This meant expediting the process of selecting general managers, determining league settings, and holding an Autopick Draft, which mostly left rosters to chance. The hope was that GMs could solve problems through trades and free agency. But as the season progressed, we saw the hasty setup lead to some unintended problems.

ROSTER REQUIREMENTS

With the league limited to 20 of the IceHL's 30 teams, each GM was given a 23-man roster with 18 starters. Amongst the starters were 9 forwards, 6 defensemen, an additional skater and 2 goalies. With the 5 bench spots, this put 460 players in the league at any given time which, a consequence of which was a diminished talent pool to some extent.

SCORING SYSTEM

Players earned points for their team based on the following statistics:

In the rush to assemble the league, the scoring was not fully researched and favored goaltenders so much that only the most talented scorers could keep pace.

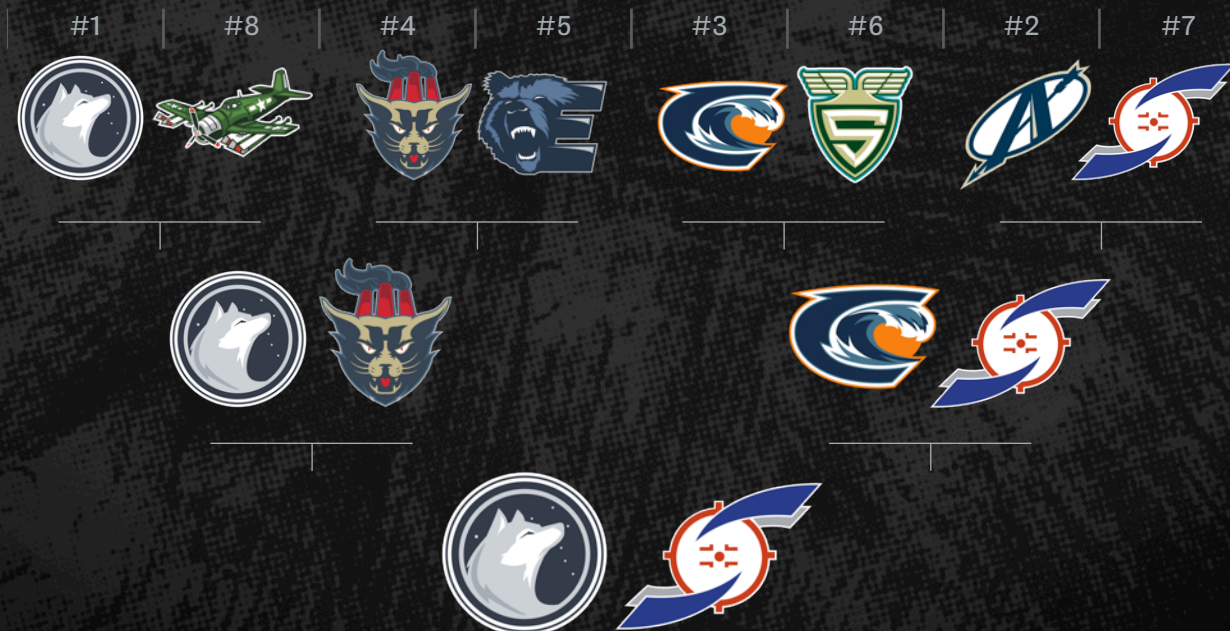

Due to ESPN Fantasy Hockey rules, the online league was restricted to 20 teams. That meant these 10 IceHL clubs went unmanaged during the inaugural season.



THE FUTURE

The resounding success of the IceHL's debut season spawned even more interest for the 2011-12 season. In order to accommodate all 30 teams, the league will split into two ESPN Fantasy Leagues.

The 15 Eastern Conference teams will face each other in **IceHL EAST** while the 15 Western Conference clubs will be part of **IceHL WEST**. Fewer teams in each league, smaller rosters of just 16 players (12 starters) and a well-balanced and researched scoring system should combine to give the IceHL's sophomore season a competitive edge over its first – especially with 30 enthusiastic owners already in place.

2011-12 IceHL Season



On Aug. 31, 2011, the second IceHL fantasy hockey season was officially announced. Nearly 150 applications were accepted as the league looked for 17 new general managers. For the first time, I decided to run a team while also serving as commissioner to both IceHL EAST and WEST.

Each GM gets a 16-man roster with 12 starters. Amongst the starters are 6 forwards, 4 defensemen, an additional skater and one goalie. With just 4 bench spots, GMs will be forced to make difficult choices to keep a balanced roster. (Rosters are limited to a maximum of 10 forwards, 6 defense and 2 goalies.)

2012 & Beyond...



As the IceHL grows in popularity and builds on its own unique history, change is inevitable. Discussed here are some of the changes in store for the future of the league in 2012 and beyond.

JERSEY DESIGN COMPETITION

The next step as the IceHL Project is revived this fall will be the Jersey Design Competition. Full details on how this process will work will be explained at www.icethetics.info/icehl.

KEEPER LEAGUE

Beginning with the 2012-13 season, the IceHL will become a keeper league. Returning GMs will be permitted to retain up to five players from their roster going into the draft. This adds an incentive for GMs not only to return but to carefully manage their rosters from year to year.

LEAGUE EXPANSION

Currently, IceHL EAST and IceHL WEST each contain an odd number of teams. This means that every week during the season, at least one is forced to sit out without an opponent. To rectify this moving forward, two new teams will be added in 2012, one for each conference. Icethetics readers will once again be called on to make these decisions by casting their votes this winter.

Voters will be presented with the top 5 cities from each conference which fell just short of getting a team in the initial creation of the IceHL. For the EAST, that will include Ottawa, Hartford, Kansas City, Cleveland and Miami. For the WEST, it will include Las Vegas, San Francisco, Phoenix, Oklahoma City and Yellowknife. From there, naming and logo design will be conducted just as before.

RELOCATION

In the summer of 2012, voters will decide whether to relocate up to two teams from each conference. The bottom 3 teams from the EAST and WEST will be put up for relocation. A 75% majority vote will be required to move a franchise. Also, the GM of any non-playoff team in 2011-12 may suggest his club for relocation. In that case, only a 66% majority vote will be required to move the franchise. Any relocated teams will require rebranding. In the event more than two teams from the same conference reach the necessary majority, the two with the highest percentages will be relocated.

REBRANDING

Also during the summer of 2012, voters will decide whether to rebrand as many as three teams from each conference. All teams not eligible for relocation will enter a multiple choice poll. Readers will note those teams they would like to see rebranded. The top 3 vote-getters from each conference will move on to individual polls. A 51% majority vote will be required to rebrand a franchise.

If a franchise is indicated for rebranding (either through relocation or basic rebranding), the process will work just as before. After a name is determined, logo designs will be accepted and voted on. The winning designs will be permanent. No team may be rebranded again until two seasons have elapsed.

LOGO DESIGN COMPETITION 2012

Between expansion, relocation and rebranding, new logos may required for as many as 12 teams (but no fewer than two) prior to the start of the 2012-13 season. Since the IceHL is a community project, new ideas and suggestions are always welcome. Please send yours to icethetics@gmail.com.
