Rhythm X Announces Additions To Educational Team, Administration

DAYTON, Ohio (June 11, 2014) - Today Rhythm X announced the addition of four staff members to its team of 17. Caleb Lamb and Jonathan Meader join the educational staff and Patrick Fitzgerald and Maddie Wessel will join the administration, bringing the entire Rhythm X, Inc. team to 21.

Caleb Lamb of Dayton, Ohio was a performing member of Rhythm X for four years as a cymbal player. He ended his performance career during the X14 season and will return as a cymbal and movement instructor for the 2015 performance season. Maddie Wessel, of Cincinnati, Ohio was also an intern last season taking an administrative role. Her work surrounded the logistics and organization of the X14 Performance Tour. She joins the team as the Administrative Supervisor and will continue to support the administration at Rhythm X.
