

# shisha pendant

a pattern by  
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## materials

For Pendant

Fingering weight yarn, about 3 yards [2.75 meters] for small and 5 yards [4.57 meters] for large. I used unlabeled cotton from my stash

For Chain

Finca Perle Cotton size 8 [100% cotton; 42 yards (38.5 meters)]: 1 (1) ball color #8742, Medium Shell Gray, about 3 yards [2.75 meters] for each chain.

Nylon beading thread

Seed beads

## the pattern

### chain

For Crochet Chain: chain until work measures about 24" [61 cm]. Break yarn and pull through last stitch.

For Beaded Chain: String seed beads until it measures about 24" .

## supplies & notions

Size 5 (1.7mm) crochet hook

Mirrors: 3/4" for small pendant, 1" for large pendant

Yarn needle

Beading needle

## finished dimensions

7/8" (1 1/4") [2 (3) cm] measured across pendant

## sizes

Small (Large)

### pendant

Round 1: Chain 12 (24). Join in round using slip stitch.

Round 2: Single crochet 16 (28) times into the ring. Join using slip stitch.

Round 3: Chain 1, then single crochet into each stitch. At end of row, use slip stitch to join in round.

Round 4: \*Chain 1, single crochet decrease, repeat from \* to end of round.

NOTE: When you have decreased about halfway around the circle, fit the mirror into place. You may have to tug the work over the edges a bit. Hold it in place while you continue decreasing to end, see photo 1.

Rounds 5-7: Continue the chain 1, single crochet decrease from round 4 in a spiral until the remaining opening is between 1/4" - 1/2" (0.5 - 1 cm) across, see photo 2.

Cut yarn and pull through working loop. Pull tightly, and stitch yarn end through opposite sides of opening to pull it closed and make the Round 1 ring tight and centered on the mirror face. Knot yarn to secure but don't cut yet.

To make hanging loop, pass yarn end up to edge of pendant. Wrap yarn around crochet hook to hold loop in place and knot yarn to hold loop in place, see photo 4. Weave in ends and cut. Thread pendant on chain, knot yarn ends and trim.
