# ARTICULATE YOUR FAITH Intentional times to talk about God's Word

- 1. What was your worst day ever? Your best day ever? How do they compare to Jesus' worst day on the cross?
- 2. Share a dating/engagement story with your family. What is the biggest thing you would do to show how much you loved someone? How does the resurrection prove how much God loves us?
- 3. What did the woman in John 4 do after she heard the good news? Would the townspeople have followed Jesus if she hadn't told them? Who is someone our family should tell about Jesus?



#### PERSONALIZE SCRIPTURE

Spontaneous times to relate your everyday life to God's Word

Look for examples of cause and effect in your home. (For example: flipping a switch turns on a light, boiling water produces steam, washing clothes removes dirt, etc.) Discuss how each action caused a response, just like God's move of sending Jesus demands a response from us: love back to him, love toward others, sharing the good news, etc.



## WORSHIP WITH YOUR LIFE Show what God has done in your life to others

Make a move that will point someone to Jesus. Get some "Just Because" cards from the church office and attach them to a small gift for a friend, neighbor or co-worker. Make your move intentionally and not just randomly!



### DIALOGUE WITH GOD Prompts to pray with your family

Dear Lord, thank You for making the big move to send Your Son to die for us. Give us the faith and courage needed to make our move. Help us to point others to You with every move we make. Amen.
