1. The Bible addresses two forms of judgment.

MAIN THOUGHT

Judge the believin' and not the non-believin'.

RIGHT JUDGMENT

- Empathetically: We acknowledge our own sinful shortcomings.
- Slowly: We need to be patient, and not rash, in our judgment.
- Strategically: We judge to protect them and not to condemn them.

WRONG JUDGMENT

- We judge the wrong target audience.
- We judge preferentially and not biblically.
- We judge hypocritically.

WHAT ABOUT THE NON-BELIEVIN'?

Show them biblical tolerance.
