MAIN THOUGHT

Judge the believin' and not the non-believin'.

RIGHT JUDGMENT

- Empathetically: We <u>acknowledge</u> our own <u>sinful</u> shortcomings.
- Slowly: We need to be <u>patient</u>, and not <u>rash</u>, in our judgment.
- Strategically: We judge to <u>protect</u> them and not to <u>condemn</u> them.

WRONG JUDGMENT


- We judge the wrong target audience.
