A GOAL WITH A TENSION

Love the sinner, hate the sin.

START HERE

- 1. <u>People</u> uniquely matter.
- 2. Sin is a real thing.

THE FIRST PART

Loving people is costly, but it is a godly investment.

• All people are worth the cost.

TWO BIG THINGS

- 1. God <u>hates</u> certain <u>behaviors</u>. (Proverbs 6:16-19)
- 2. God commands his people to hate evil. (Psalm 97:10)

WHY HATE SIN?

Sin is always destructive.

• Any <u>amount</u> of sin is destructive to the <u>name</u> of God and <u>life</u> of a person.

WATCH OUT

Embracing what God does not embrace.

A STRATEGY FOR HATING SIN

Be in and not of.

NOT OF

- 1. Hear the warning.
- 2. Identify the source of the want.
- 3. Keep proper <u>perspective</u>.
