Types of classes at the IEC

The following types of classes are offered at the International Education Center. See the Class Schedule on our website to find out what classes are currently available.

English as a second language (ESL) classes – We offer seven levels of English classes – from beginning to advanced – with a focus on speaking and listening, and reading, writing and grammar.

GED preparation class – Our GED preparation class helps students prepare for the social studies, science, writing, and reading sections of the GED exam.

Math classes – We offer three levels of math classes. The basic level focuses on addition, subtraction and multiplication. The intermediate level focuses on division, fractions and decimals. The advanced level focuses on pre-algebra, algebra and geometry.

Computer skills classes – We offer two computer skills classes that focus on skills like basic computer use, internet searches, writing emails and using Microsoft Word.

Other classes – Additional classes are offered as demand and resources allow, such as TOEFL, workplace communication, study skills, citizenship and more. Please see the Class Schedule link on the website to find out what classes we currently offer.
