## GALLERY AT THE WALL AT ROTARY COMMON

During the past several years we have witnessed a dramatic renewal of Rotary Common. The Labyrinth and Reflection Garden is a unique and beautiful addition to the park, serving as place of peace and tranquility.

With the support of the Mayor, business leaders and the Adult Learning Center Executive Director, and the ALC as the Fiscal Agent, a new project has begun, The Gallery at the Wall at Rotary Common. Dedication is planned for the spring of 2013.



This project will transform a decaying wall supporting the parking lot of the Nashua Adult Learning Center, which abuts Rotary Common, into an Outdoor Art Gallery. The vision is to make this 180 foot wall into an historic tribute to the City of Nashua by displaying Nashua's past, in both illustrations and written passages, and a celebration of the vibrancy of our city in the present, depicted in 12 photographic panels, each 3 feet by 4.5 feet.



The wall, as a rotating gallery, will also serve as a living monument to the Greater Nashua Community, by providing future artists a platform for their creativity and expression. This Art Gallery for the City of Nashua will not only beautify the park but serve as place where we can celebrate our city's heritage and accomplishments. The cost of the project is \$15,000.
