

Summary of Proposed Changes to King of Glory By Laws

A number of changes are being proposed to modify the King of Glory By Laws. The list below is a summary of the changes that have been made. In addition to this list, the detailed changes that are being proposed are also available for review.

1. **Leadership Development Committee name change.** Changed "Nominating Committee" to "Leadership Development Committee" throughout the bylaws to better reflect the responsibilities of this committee
2. **Termination of membership by Deacon Committee.** Added section 7.4.e. to clarify that the Deacon Committee also has authority to terminate an individual's membership in King of Glory
3. **Revised definition of a quorum.** Changed Section 9.3 to incorporate a new definition of quorum to require at least 15% of the current membership. This will allow for growth in our congregation.
4. **Defined the definition of 2011 dollars.** Added clarification of the index used to determine 2011 dollars to sections 11.6.c and 11.6.d
5. **Modifications to the Executive Committee.** Several other wording changes are proposed to sections 10 and 11 in order to make the following changes:
 1. Under the current structure there is concern that when a new member is elected to the Executive Committee, the role, responsibilities and level of commitment is not known since the exact position is not decided at the time of election to the Executive Committee. As a result, we are proposing that the members of the Executive Committee are elected into specific positions as noted in section 11.4.
 2. In order to maintain as much consistency in leadership as possible within the Executive Committee, it is proposed that any vacancies of the President and Vice President positions are filled from within the Executive Committee. This was added to section 11.2.
 3. Wording was added to clarify the length of term for vacated positions. Also, added sentence at the end of 11.3 to clarify that anyone who fulfills a vacated position can be reelected to the Executive Committee the following year.
6. **Establish a standing Finance Committee.** Several changes were made in section 12 in order to establish the standing Finance Committee and remove the finance trustee:
 1. In section 12.1 remove the "finance" trustee due to the creation of a standing Finance Committee,
 2. Section 12.1.1.IV is removed due to the creation of standing Finance Committee
 3. Section 12.5 is added to establish the standing Finance Committee
7. **Election of Leadership Development Committee.** In section 12.4 the wording is changed to reflect the election of new members for Leadership Development Committee as decided in 2011
8. **Require 2/3 majority to change By Laws.** In section 15.1, the wording is changed so that a majority of 2/3 votes will be required to change bylaws in the future.
