

## The medallion Louis gave to Zelig during their wedding ceremony, July 13, 1858

As a souvenir of their marriage, Louis Martin designed a medallion as a gift for Zelig. As they exchanged their vows, the priest blessed the medallion. Louis slipped the wedding ring on the finger of Zelig's right hand, and then placed the medallion in her left hand, saying "Receive the symbol of our wedding promises." Below are photographs of both sides of the original medallion, now located at the bishopric of the diocese of Sees, in which Zelig was born.
