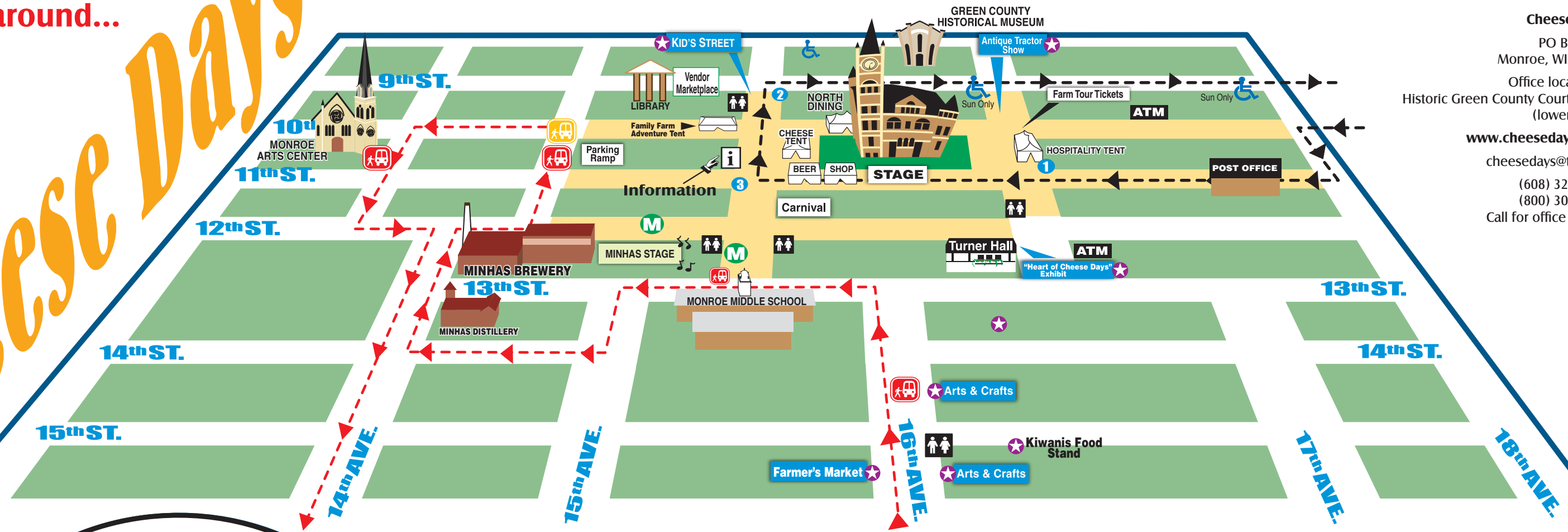


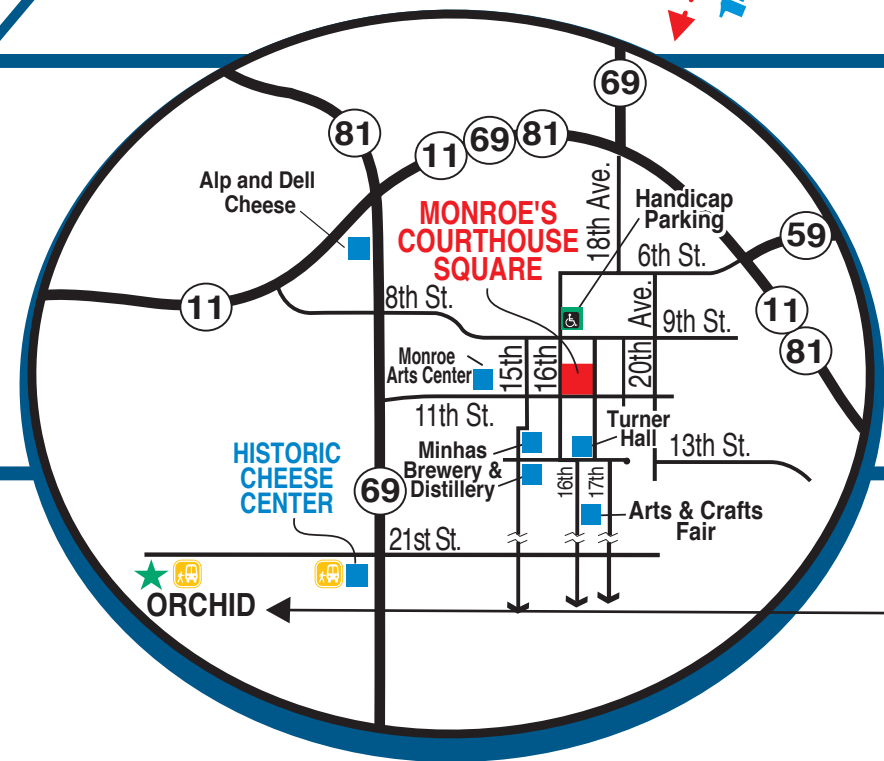

 Continuous loops with stops at locations marked on map. An additional tram stop (not shown on map) is "Smokey Row" near the intersection of 17th St. and 14th Ave. by Friendly Inn. So this is another "Park and Ride" option on Saturday.

PARK & RIDE SHUTTLE BUS: \$1 PER TRIP - BUSES MAKE CONTINUOUS LOOPS.

Park at: ORCHID (350 - 21st St.)

Directions to Orchid

- FROM THE SOUTH - coming into Monroe on Hwy. 69: At the first stop light (Phillips 66 - Lucky 7 gas station on your right, Historic Cheese Center on your left) - take a LEFT onto 21st St.
- FROM THE NORTH: Take Hwy. 69 south. At the stop light with National Historic Cheese Center on the right and Phillips 66 - Lucky 7 gas station on the left, turn RIGHT onto 21st St.

Drop Off & Pick Up Sites:

- Friday 5-11 pm: Orchid, Downtown
- Saturday 10 am - 11 pm: Orchid, Historic Cheese Center, Downtown Parking Ramp, & *Fairgrounds. (*there is also street parking around Fairgrounds)
- Sunday 10 am - 5 pm: Orchid, Historic Cheese Center and Downtown Parking Ramp.

- Handicap Parking** - must display appropriate disabled parking identification to avoid being towed.
- North Municipal lot 8th St. & 16th Ave. (near Stop 'N Go and the Green County Historical Museum) **All Weekend**
- Lot at corner of 9th Street & 18th Avenue. (east of Wisconsin Community Bank **Sunday Only**)
- East School Park (900 block of 22nd Ave. and 900 block of 24th Ave.) **Sunday Only**
- First National Bank Parking Lot - **Sunday Only**
- Wisconsin Community Bank - **Sunday Only**
- Handicap Parade Viewing** - terrace areas along parking lots of Wisconsin Community Bank and First National Bank. Canopy tents are also set up for shaded areas for handicap viewing at East School Park.
- Tour Bus Parking** - Contact the Cheese Days office.
