
The Elisa Monte Dance Company has again shown New York City why it is in such high demand in the dance venues around

It's not surprising that Elisa Monte has claimed her rightful place as one of the stateswomen of dance. Renowned as an innovative choreographer, she leads a company of superb dancers that captures the audience with its physically intense style and technical acuity. Acclaimed as a dancer, herself, Monte's stage presence included roles as principal dancers with the Martha Graham Dance Company, Lar Lubovitch and Pilobolus.

Monte's earliest work, Treading (1979), has been followed by nearly 50 other creations, including choreography created in residencies around the world. Many of her works have been developed through partnerships, exploring cultural influences through the engagement of others, private research, and public discussions.

With 8 powerful dancers, Elisa Monte Dance sizzles with excitement and energy, as it travels the globe each season. Whether in Texas or half way around the world in Luxembourg, this seasoned dance company takes the stage, capturing audiences with exceptional choreography, beautiful lighting, creative costuming and exceptional execution.

Lonely Planet

Lonely Planet is a new multimedia dance collaboration between choreographer Elisa Monte, composer David Van Tieghem, lighting designer Clifton Taylor, set designer Peter Darche and projectionist Paul Lieber. Truly lights, camera and action, Lonely Planet caps Elisa Monte's four year investigation of issues related to existence, permanence and the ephemeral nature of living, which have been explored previously in Vanishing Languages (2010), Unstable Ground (2011), and Terra Firma (2012). Lonely Planet is Elisa Monte's 2014 premiere and will be the finale in this evening-long performance.

Contemporary Classics

A program of audience favorites from over three decades that includes Elisa's signature piece Treading(1979), the heart-pounding Shattered (2000), the sculptural, beautiful Volkmann Suite (1999) and the rhythmic tour de force Pigs and Fishes (1982).

EMD Today
