

The ideal small touring car, with two doors, detachable sliding windows and a bench type front seat. Powered with the Ford Consul or Zodiac O.H.V. engine.

Visibility is exceedingly good with the low front, and large windscreen. A large carpet - lined luggage locker is fitted and supplemented by considerable space behind the Dunlopillo trimmed bucket seats.
